The youth theatre company's 10-week production programs welcome youths aged 10 to 20 to learn all aspects of putting on a play - from acting to set construction and costume design to lighting and choreography.

After the success of the fall program, Alexandra, the company's owner and artistic director, moved full speed ahead with the winter program: a new production of Canadian playwright Dennis Foon's 'Mirror Game'. At the end of March the young actors perform this play at the Acton Town Hall Centre as well as at high schools in Orangeville and Guelph.

The group has also been invited to perform at a youth festival in Sault Sainte Marie. "This is why I started the company," says Alexandra, who studied theatre at the University of Ottawa, the University of Toronto and the American Musical and Dramatic Academy in NYC.
