On Wednesday nights, dancers of all levels are invited to learn how to line dance from 6:30 p.m. onward. Thursday is hosted by Z103.5, where the latest Top 40 hits are played; and Saturday is the bar's legendary country and line dancing night.

"It's a great atmosphere with no attitude," says Kit Andrew, CEO of 13Thirteen Entertainment. "There's electricity here. It's a unique place to come and be entertained."

Nashville North is also home to The Tennessee Chop House, a southern barbecue-style restaurant that serves up Nashville favourites such as steaks, smoked BBQ ribs and housemade pulled pork sandwiches, with a real southern twist.

Guests can sit back, relax and enjoy a tasty meal while watching the line dancers and after dinner, joining along.

In 1991, a group of concerned citizens banded together and opened Wastewise to provide Halton Hills residents alternative ways to divert unwanted items from the landfill.

As a one-stop shop for all your recycling and reusing needs the centre's reuse section takes in a variety of good-quality items - including books, clothing, dishes, small appliances, furniture and more - and resells them. In addition to accepting your household E-Waste including stereos, TV's, computers and cell phones, Wastewise also has a recycling section for common items like paper and cardboard.

While reusing and recycling are a major part of Wastewise's mandate, education is also very important. Local green clubs, school groups, Scout troops and Guide groups visit the centre to learn about recycling and the environment.

To celebrate its 20th anniversary, Wastewise gave away \$20,000 to a variety of local organizations, including P.O.W.E.R., local high school scholarships and environmental programs, and the Acton BIA.

"We're pleased to finally be in a position to give away money," says manager Debbie Smart. "At the beginning, our goal was just to be self sustaining."

Debbie wants to thank all the volunteers, board members, local businesses and staff members who have made Wastewise what it is today.

"Our staff and volunteers are awesome. I don't know what we'd do without them!" she says.
