Halton Hills is seeing a freight train coming right at us in the form of the 4-3 Superhighway that will slash through the heart of our community.

The GTA West Corridor team are still trying to justify this highway despite the fact Halton Hills Council has proved to them Hwy 401 can be widened to 12 lanes; with next to no impact to the present landowners on either side.

To me, this is the most cost effective method.

Why do council and residents continue to fight this 4-3 Superhighway? Not only are hundreds of rural land owners being directly impacted, but this will fundamentally change Halton Hills forever. 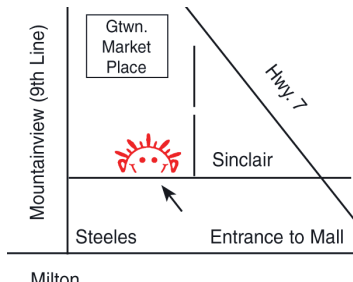
