



About Georgetown Hospital

Georgetown Hospital is a busy community hospital built on 17 acres of land in the heart of Halton Hills. The Hospital provides mostly primary care to the residents of the Town of Halton Hills, which includes the towns and villages of: Acton, Ballinafad, Churchill (Hamlet), Georgetown, Glen Williams, Limehouse, Norval (Village of), Stewarttown and Terra Cotta.

Offering a wide range of primary care services, the Hospital's major clinical areas include emergency services, obstetrics, general medicine, surgery and complex continuing care. The emergency department, open 24 hours a day, seven days a week, provides service to more than 31,000 patients annually. The Obstetrical Unit's labour, delivery and post partum beds can accommodate seven patients and delivers more than 400 babies each year.

The Hospital currently serves an urban and rural population of approximately 55,289. The population is expected to increase over the next several years. Halton Healthcare Services is planning to expand clinical services at the Hospital as the community continues to grow and age.



Georgetown Hospital Foundation

The Georgetown Hospital Foundation raises funds to support the purchase of vital medical equipment at Georgetown Hospital. The Foundation is a registered charitable organization governed by a volunteer board of directors who live in Halton Hills and are dedicated to supporting healthcare in their community.
