## Georgetown man faces charges after driver stopped in Guelph

A Georgetown man is facing charges after Guelph Police stopped a man for driving erratically on Woolwich St. near McTague St., Guelph Sunday.

Halton Police report the vehicle was involved in a collision in Milton about 8 p.m on Sixth Line Nassagewaya.

The vehicle, a 2003 Ford 450 that had been taken from a Rockwood business sometime over the weekend, had sideswiped another vehicle while passing it, causing damage to the utility trailer being pulled behind the victim's vehicle, and the driver's side

door handle.

The driver failed to stop, and the victim followed the vehicle and contacted police who advised him to stop following the driver for safety reasons.

Guelph Police stopped the vehicle about 9 p.m.
