Zellers store is no more

After 40 years, Zellers in the Georgetown Market Place is no more.

Following months of liquaation sales, the store shut its doors Wednesday and began removing its iconic sign Thursday.

An official with the company's head office last month refused an Independent & Free Press request to do a story on the closing by interviewing local staff.

Last September, through a three-store deal between Zellers' parent company Hudson Bay Company, Target and Walmart, the Georgetown Zellers' lease

Walmart plans to make a 17,000 sq. ft. renovation/expansion to that location, and move there from its current location in the middle of the mall.
