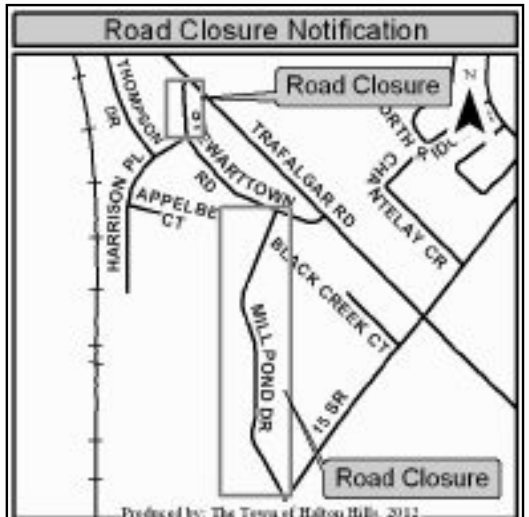


TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURES
