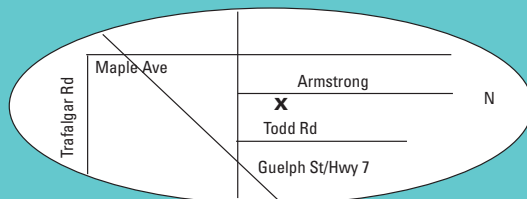

## Fire calls: Motorcyclist injured

Halton Hills firefighters were called out to 15 Sideroad and Regional Rd. 25 for a motorcycle accident about 4:30 a.m. Monday, June 11.

The rider suffered head injuries in the crash that occurred when he swerved to avoid hitting an animal. Halton Police and EMS were already on the scene when firefighters arrived.

On Saturday (June 16) at 5:29 a.m. firefighters were called to the apartment above the Salvation Army Store, 82 Mill St. in Georgetown for a fire.

An unattended candle caused contents in the bedroom to ignite. Working smoke alarms alerted the residents to smoke in their home.

The homeowners attempted to ex-

tinguish the fire and, upon arrival, fire crews finished putting the fire out and ventilated smoke from the apartment.

Firefighters responded to a single-vehicle accident on Guelph St. about 10:30 p.m. Monday (June 11) when a vehicle struck a hydro pole.

The driver suffered minor injuries. Guelph St. was closed for some time while hydro workers repaired the pole.

About 11 p.m. Thursday (June 14) firefighters were called to 20 Fagan Dr. because hydro wires had broken away from the pole and on fire.

Halton Hills Hydro removed the broken hydro wires from the pole and house.
