


## Mayor's Corner



The census numbers are out. Milton is once again the fastest growing community in Canada, growing at a rate of over 56.5 per cent from 2006-2011. In the 2006 census Milton grew by 70 per cent, to a population of 84,000. Mayor Gord Krantz had told me it is over 100,000 now. Brampton's population has also grown over 20 per cent in the same timeframe. Here in Halton Hills our population has grown by 6.7 per cent which is slightly above the National average. Our population is 59,000.

It just shows you the growth pressure that Halton Hills has been under the past 10 years. Town Council has done its best to manage our growth. All communities need modest growth. I think the recent statistics from Census Canada show that we have managed our growth.
