Yard Waste Collection

- Use paper yard waste bags or reusable, rigid containers (no lid).
- No plastic bags.
- Tie and bundle brush.

From April 2 to December 14, 2012, yard waste is collected once every other week, on the same day as your garbage.

Yard waste in cardboard boxes, Blue Boxes, GreenCarts, plastic bags, compostable bags or biodegradable bags will not be collected.




Yard waste labels are available at no charge. To order a yard waste label, visit www.halton.ca/wastetools, or call Halton Region by dialing 311.

Place yard waste labels on your reusable container.

Containers must be no heavier than 23 kg (50 lbs) and may have a capacity up to 125 L (27.5 gallons).

Brush must be tied in bundles no larger than 1.2 m x 0.6 m (4 ft x 2 ft) wide, with branches a maximum of 7.5 cm (3 in) in diameter.

Grass clippings are **not** accepted in Yard Waste collection. Please "grasscycle" by leaving grass clippings on your lawn. Grass clippings will decompose quickly, releasing valuable nutrients back into your soil. Grass clippings are not accepted in the garbage, Blue Box or GreenCart.





- Leaves and weeds
- Sticks, twigs and tree trimmings
- Decorative cornstalks

Price of local politics

The cost of council last year in Halton Hills was \$334,208, and another \$5,952 for remuneration and expenses for the seven members of the Town's Committee of Adjustment.

An annual mandatory remuneration and expenses report showed Mayor Rick Bonnette earned a total of \$70,226 in 2001 - \$63,269 in salary and benefits, \$2,242 for conferences and seminars, and \$4,715 for parking, ETR and kilometrage.
