# Diversity is the key to survival, says Town's EDO Penrice

Food processing. Advanced manufacturing. Logistics and distribution. Service and retail. Agriculture and horticulture. Creative. For a small town, Halton Hills is home to a surprisingly diverse assortment of industries.

Approximately 3,000 businesses are nestled in the town's rolling hills and open spaces, from large companies with an international reach to small one-man operations run out of the owner/operator's home.

Economic diversity is a big change from the 1960s and 70s when the local economy was dominated by paper mills. In fact, this diversity is one of the main reasons the local economy weathered the recent economic downturn so successfully, says Doug Penrice, the Economic Development Officer for the Town of Halton Hills.
