"It will help set priorities and guide the completion of key Town plans, policies, studies and various other initiatives. The overarching objective will be to ensure that everyone in Halton Hills enjoys an even higher quality of life, where our businesses and neighbourhoods thrive.

"As we near the Strategy's completion, we will reach out to a wide variety of community partners in order to jointly advance the Strategy's implementation," he added. "We look forward to taking action on this important blueprint for our community's future."

The community vision is supported by four distinct 'pillars' that address




