The Sept. 7 lunch will be potluck. Don't forget you have to sign up by Wednesday of next week so the meals can be planned.

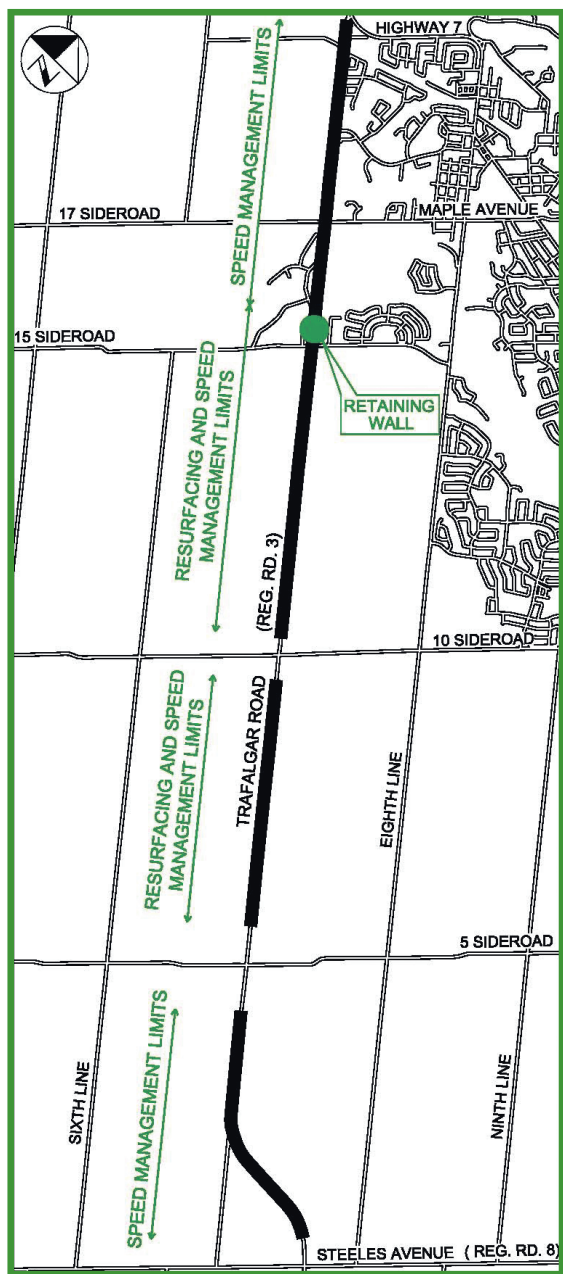
