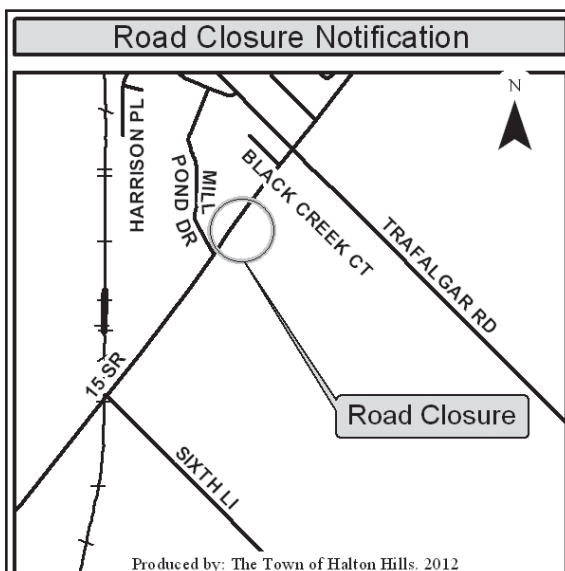


TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE
