"She didn't tell me what happened," said Sullivan. "As an organization we don't really care. The only thing we care about is everyone is safe and sound."

Sullivan said he was thrilled "the driver is fine, everyone here is fine and there was no damage."

He estimated there were approximately 24 people in BAO at the time of the collision.

and he doesn't believe anyone heard or felt anything when the SUV hit the building.

Sullivan said BAO closed briefly Saturday while an inspector assessed if there was any structural damage. As there was none, the business was reopened within a couple of hours of the accident.
