spree which caused between \$12,000 and \$50,000 damage, - uncovered on Monday at Yourway Auto on Main St. North. The 10 and 12 year olds were discovered in a trailer at the close of business and police were called.

The vandalism - broken mirrors, spray painting, scratches and dents - was done to numerous trucks, a boat, trailers and a 1967

Chevy Nova show car.

Both youths were released without charges and the 12 year old was referred to the Youth Justice Program.

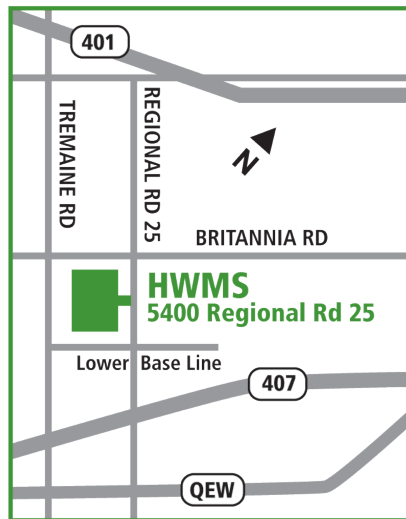
