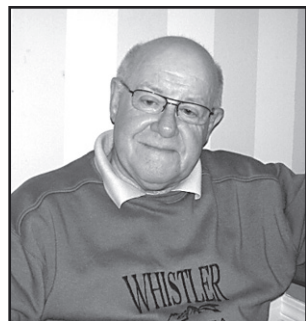


SELIG: Kimberly Ann (née Smith)
