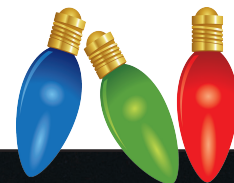
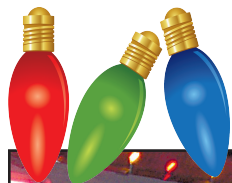


# Rockwood's Parade of Lights
