

Playoff slate busy for Acton rep puck squads

Acton Minor Hockey Association rep squads have been busy of late.

The Acton Firefighter bantam squad had netted three straight wins over Fergus, including the last two Ontario Minor Hockey Association playoff contests.

Acton ended the regular season with a 10-1 win over Fergus for a 15-2-2 record on the Hub League season. Mike Kinnon had four goals for the winners while Wayne Bousfield added three goals. John McLean, Jason McNaught and Jason Piper had the others. Bousfield had three assists while Piper and Sean Fosbury had a pair of helpers.

In the first game of their OMHA set Acton claimed a 4-1 win. Kinnon had three goals while McLean had the other. In Game Two the Acton club took a 9-5 decision. McNaught had three goals in the game while singles went to Bousfield, Piper, McLean, Scott Cripps, Kinnon and Matthew Marcoux. Bousfield had four assists while Piper and McNaught added three apiece.

Meanwhile the Acton Rotary Juniors are tied 1-1 in their OMHA best-of-seven set with Beeton. Acton took the first game 6-2 as John Van Dam led the way with four goals. Paul Campbell and Chris LeBlanc had the others. Two of Van Dam's tallies came while Acton was shorthanded. Netminder Al Scott also played well in the win.

In Game Two Beeton netted four power play tallies en route to a 4-0

win over the Acton squad. The two teams return to Acton later tonight at the Acton Arena.

The Acton A-B Foodland novices split their final two regular season games, dropping a tough 2-1 decision to Erin but rebounding with a 7-0 win over Guelph. Against Erin Derrick McIntyre had the goal. Kyle Crawford played well in the Acton goal, making several big saves. In the Guelph win Derrick McIntyre had two goals while singles went to David Lajeunesse, Marc Forbes, Paul Guy, Brian McIntyre and Richard Paulis. Philip McIntyre and Brian McIntyre both had two assists in the game. Goalie Sterling Luedee had his first shutout of the year.

The novices then met up with New Hamburg in the OMHA playoffs but lost three straight. Now the club is awaiting the start of their Hub League playoffs.

in the second round of OMHA playoffs.

Fergus jumped out to a 2-0 series lead after two games. Fergus took the first game 8-2. In Game Two the Acton squad closed the gap, losing 6-4. 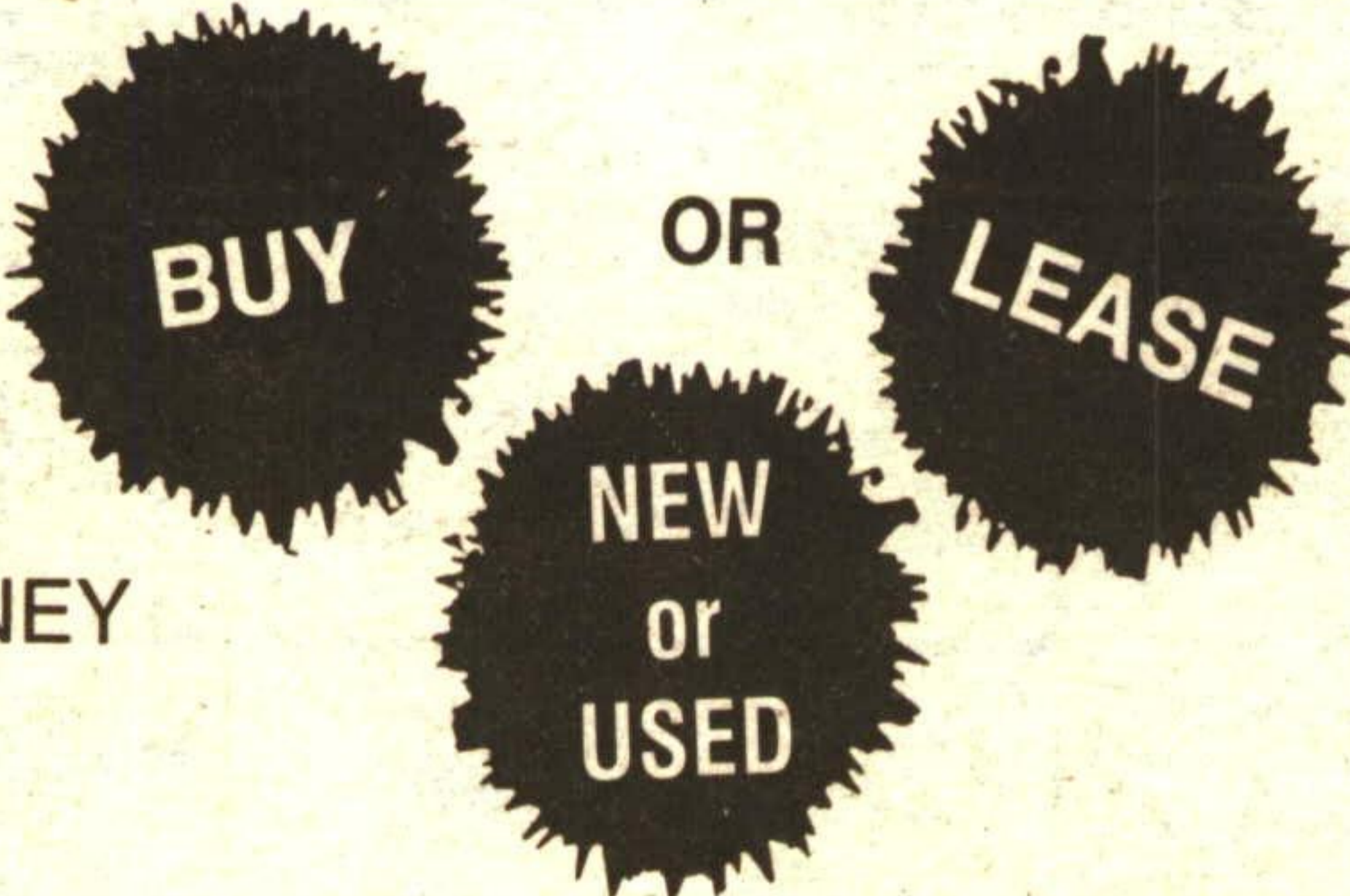
