Van Louwe said Acton is included in what is known as the Toronto II area. Grants are determined by what is known as the Maximum Unit Price (MUPs). In Acton up to \$108,000 can be spent on a two bedroom townhousestyle unit. A three bedroom townhouse may cost upt o \$116,000.

Neither Halton Non!profit Housing Corp. secretary Stan Barkovitz, or president Walter Mulkewich were available to comment before deadline Thursday.

But, Halton Hills Mayor Russ Miller did go on record saying he is aware of the project and that he supplied a list of 10 sites to the Regional Non-profit Housing Corp.

Miller added that a report on the development will be placed before municipal council Monday night.

Two doctors charged with licence offence

Two Georgetown doctors are scheduled to appear in provincial court this month on charges of operating an unlicensed specimen collection centre. They have been charged by the Ontario Ministry of Health with operating and maintaining a specimen collection centre in April of 1988 and September without the authority of a licence.

The allegation comes under Section 63 (3) of the Laboratory and Specimen Collection Centre Licensing Act.

Unlocked carsentered
