> One of the first steps involved is a self assessment. You must ask yourself questions like what are my likes and dislikes, what activities do I enjoy most, and what are my short and long term goals?







be sure to point the roots straight down and water deeply. Don't water with a sprinkler because you will deteriorate it's regal flower. Gerberas enjoy heavy regular feeding schedules but do not exceed recommended application rates. It is best to water under the bloom especially during hot weather. Do not let Gerbera sit in moist soil for they will rot easily. Remove dead blooms and older leaves as they discolor and this plant will last as a potted plant in flower until mid October, mid November, depending on how much sun you can provide. If you plan on bringing it indoors to enjoy after the summer, before placing in the garden, transplant it into an 8-10 inch clay pot with fresh soil and slow release nutricote fertilizer then submerge it in the ground. When
