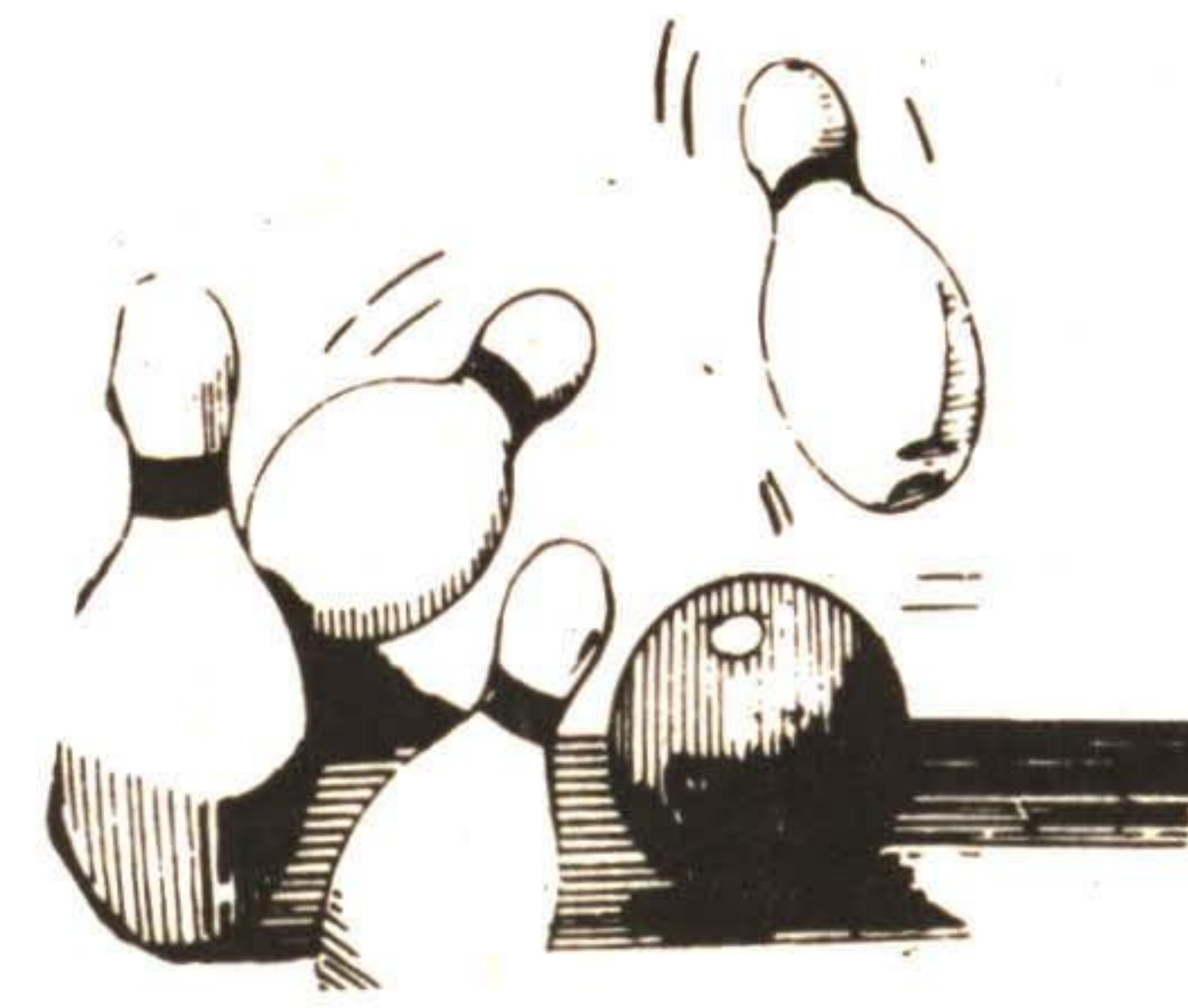


Acton House League winners
