

Revitalized Western horse show in Erin

E.B.H.O. (Erin, Ballinacraig, Hillsburgh, Ospringe) Saddle Club has been holding horse shows at the Erin Fairgrounds since 1967. There are two separate shows running at the same time—one ring features English classes and the other, horses shown under Western tack.

Entries in the Western Division had been declining over the past few years. For example, 10 years ago they might have had anywhere from 20 to 30 people in a class, compared to last year when there may have only been two to three people in a class. Hillsburgh residents Kim Robertson and Joan Ineson have taken on the responsibility of reviving the Western Division. In order to stimulate entries for the Western Division, there will be substantial prize money offered in almost all of the classes. (\$70 in open classes, \$30 in youth classes—18 and under)

The first show of this season will be held at Erin fair grounds on Sunday, May 13 starting at 10 a.m., rain or shine.

This show starts with Lead Line, for riders 7 and under,

followed by Walk-Jog (riders 11 and under). For youth (18 and under), there is showmanship, pleasure, horsemanship, barrel race, pole bending and stake race. For adults, there is halter, showmanship, pleasure for horses four years old and under, open pleasure, horsemanship, trail, English pleasure, barrel race, pole bending and Dash for Cash.

Spectators are welcome to come and watch some of the top Western riders in the vicinity compete. There will be food available on the grounds. (Profits from barbecue will go to E.B.H.O.)

- Many of us who compete regularly started out at E.B.H.O.

- It's a great way to meet friends and get started into showing.

- A lot of (Western Clubs) have been struggling over the last few years to keep in existence due to lack of entries, sponsors and volunteers.

- Hopefully, if anyone who has horses and rides western reads this, it might encourage them to come out and see what showing is all about. (You have to start somewhere!)

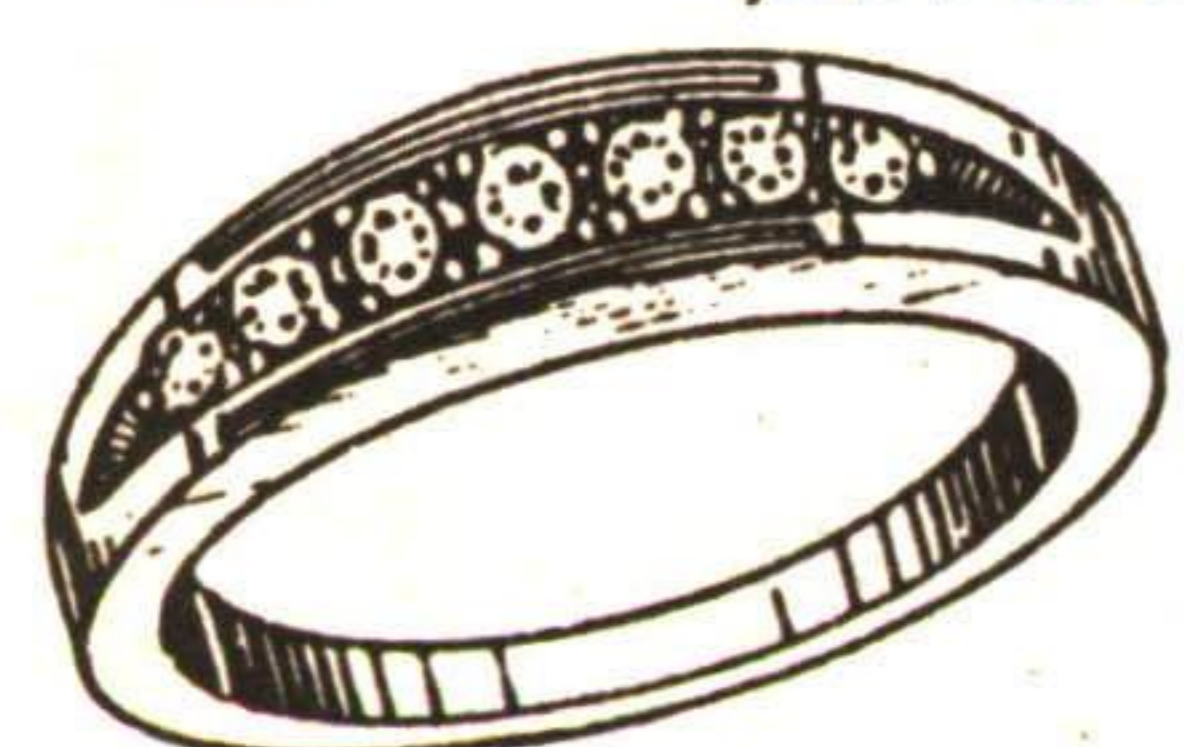
