Harmony was critically injured in the accident that took the lives of her mother and sister.

"I sat down a while ago and told Harmony about her mom and sister," Smith said. "She's had a couple of periods of remorse about it and I guess it will take a long time for her to get over it."

The Georgetown District High School student was airlifted from the scene of the accident to Sunnybrook where she underwent a 12hour operation to remove a blood clot from her brain.




