Cruise plays Cole Trickle, an ambitious race car driver who hooks up with a weasel businessman (played meticulously by Randy Quaid) who in turn pairs up Trickle with legendary NASCAR crew chief Harry Hogge (Robert Duvall) who reluctantly takes Trickle under his wing. Between Hogge's skill at building race cars and Trickle's radical racing techniques, they formulate a winning combination that soars to the top of the NASCAR circuit.

And when Trickle smashes his vehicle on the track, his attending physician (Nicole Kidman) becomes the obligatory Cruise love interest, rounding out the paint by numbers plot. The plot, which more than once, makes you think you're watching Top Gun II. Everything seems vaguely familiar and for that reason, Days Of Thunder is a little disappointing.






