A totally unfeeling machine - hence the new and improved RoboCop 2.

And the first assignment for the brand new RoboCop is to destroy its predecessor, but as they quickly discover, it's hard to keep a good cyborg down.

Meanwhile the crime rate of Detroit has escalated beyond belief, with the city held hostage by a psycho cult leader named Caine, who controls his followers through his proliferation of a new designer drug called Nuke.




