SHAMU™, SHOWS AND SOMETHING FOR EVERYONE AT SEA WORLD - FLORIDA

ORLANDO, FL - The sea's mystery and wonder await discovery at Sea World of Florida, the world's most famous and popular marine life park. Sea World's undisputed star is Shamu the killer whale, the most magnificent and awesome of marine mammals.

The Shamu family of killer whales, including Baby Namu™, born at Sea World of Florida's Shamu Stadium on July 11, 1989, is featured in "Shamu: New Visions™." This living documentary fosters an appreciation and understanding of "the great blackfish," and pays tribute to the mammal held in reverence by the Killer Whale Clan of the Alaskan Tlingit Indians. Performances at Shamu Stadium now feature a state-of-the-art, high-resolution video screen that allows guests to experience the exciting presentation like never before, with an up-close look at the killer whales and their trainers.

From the sunlit expanse of the five million-gallon Shamu Stadium to the dark, mysterious, underwater environment of Sharks!, the adventure continues.

One of Sea World's most popular exhibits, Sharks!, is an introduction to "nature's most perfect eating machine." It

features a people mover encased in a three-inch-thick, clear acrylic tube, which transports visitors underwater through a 635,000-gallon sea water aquarium. Nearly three dozen sharks, including sand tiger, bull, brown and nurse species, glide over and around the tunnel in silent welcome to their naturalistic habitat.

Sea Lions and Otters

Sea World's own marine mammal comedians star in "Clyde and Seamore 10,000 B.C.," a spoof of ancient history which takes the Stone Age by storm, making discoveries which will environmentally impact the future. After seeing this show at the 3,000 seat Sea Lion and Otter Stadium, modern man may never be the same.

The "USO Water Ski Show" takes place at the park's 17-acre Atlantis Lagoon. The red, white and blue spectacular salutes the men and women in uniform, and stars the world-famous Sea World skiers. This presentation showcases championship talents in high-jinks water skiing, long distance jumping, graceful water ballet and acrobatic barefoot-skiing antics.

"Tramp Cat Alley" is the all-new acrobatic spectacular at the 3,200-seat

Nautilus Showplace, and these cats can really fly. The "cats" are actually members of the International Aerial Trampoline Team, and they do more than just bounce and pounce when they tell a story. The theme of the show is a lighthearted look at one of nature's most mysterious creatures. Guests will marvel at the high-flying trampoline acrobatics, and will love the tale of life in the big city... from a cat's point of view.

Sea World presents "Window to the Sea," a multimedia presentation which goes not only behind the scenes at the world's most popular marine life park, but also to the depths of the ocean in search of the rare six-gilled shark. Other Marine Animals

At the Whale and Dolphin Stadium, three species of toothed whales and dolphins are introduced as they perform together for the first time anywhere. The "New Friends" show, sponsored by Kodak, highlights the individual talents and unique personalities of one of the world's largest troupes of gentle

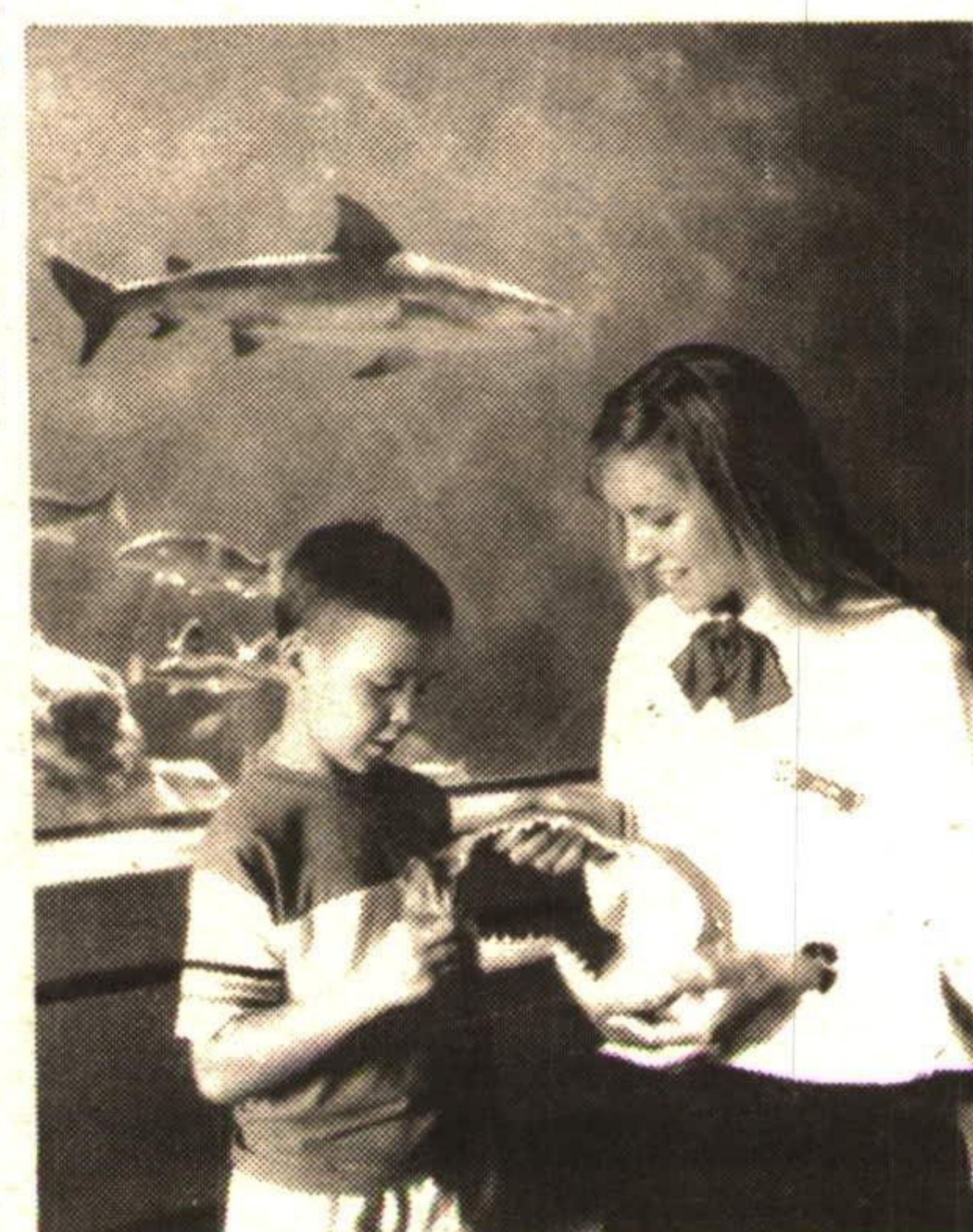
beluga whales, sleek pseudorca whales and friendly Atlantic bottlenose dolphins.

Nestled between the Sea Lion and Otter and the Whale and Dolphin Stadiums is the five-acre site of the \$13 million Penguin Encounter™, the largest exhibit of its kind in the world. Home to hundreds of penguins and alcid (birds native to the Antarctic and Arctic regions, respectively), the science center entertains and educates guests and serves as a living laboratory for protecting and preserving polar life.

For those who want a unique look at marine life, the Tropical Reef offers a scuba diver's perspective on thousands of exotic inhabitants of the world's oceans. Tropical fish from great reefs of the Caribbean, South Pacific and Australia form an ever-changing rainbow against the colorful background. The 160,000-gallon man-made coral reef is surrounded by 17 individual display aquariums.

At the Stingray Lagoon, guests may feed and touch harmless southern diamond and cow nose rays. Other hands-on exhibits in the park include seal and sea lion community pools, a Tide Pool exhibit, and areas for observing and interacting with

bottlenose dolphins.

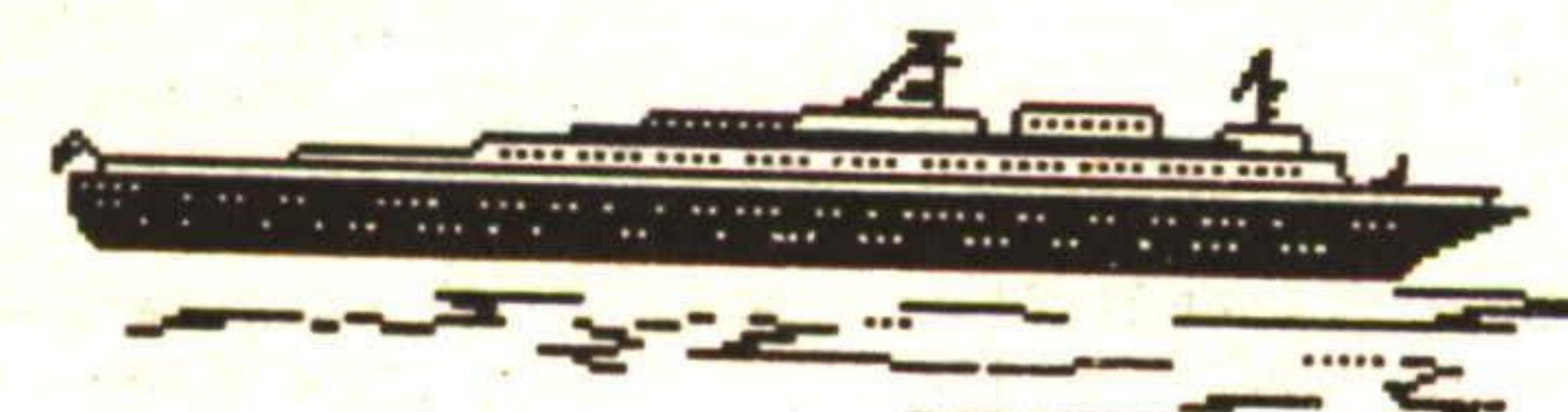

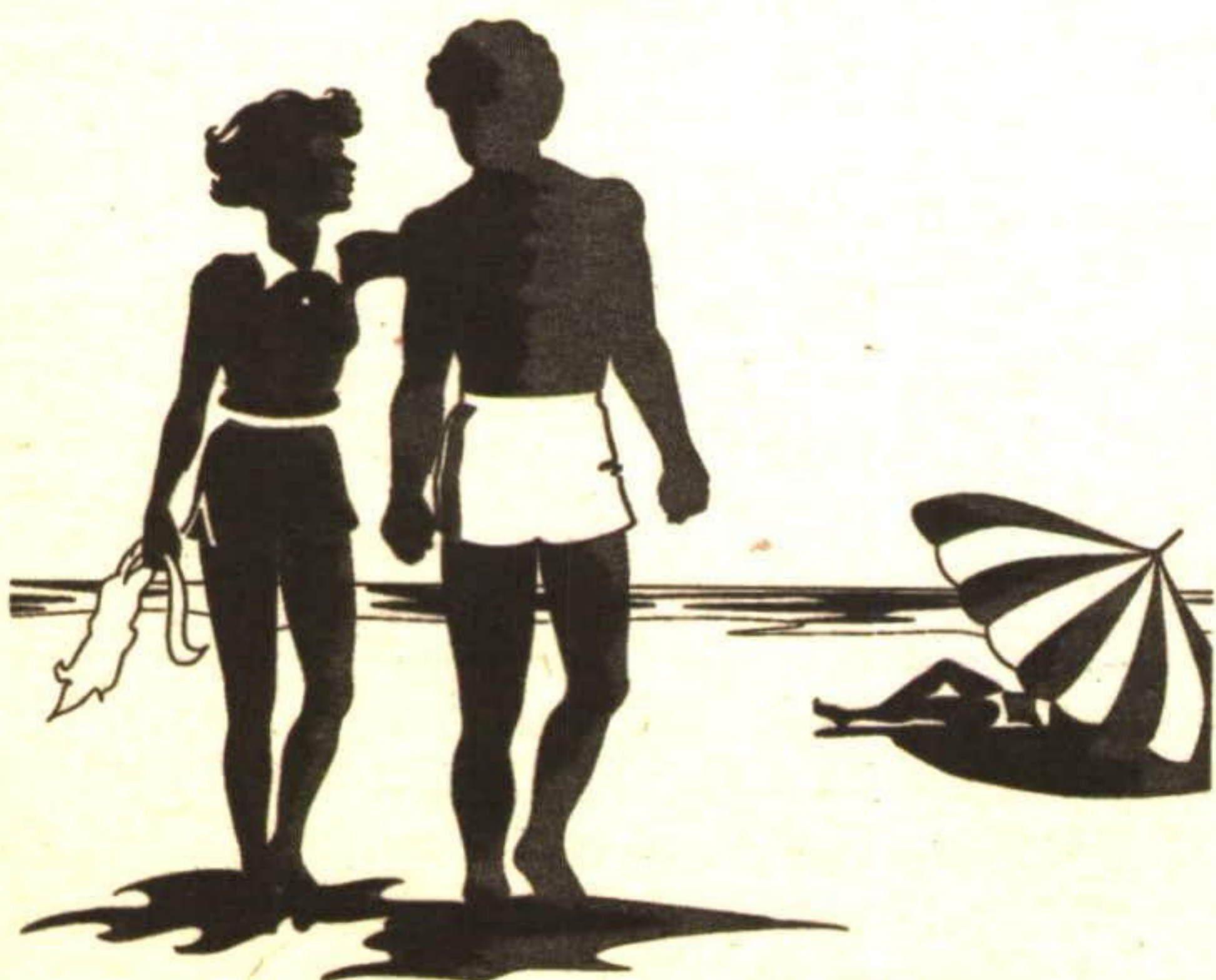
