For the first time in North Halton, a program is underway to help families of schizophrenics.

Run by the North Halton Mental Health Association, the sixweek sessions, which started last week, are being run out of its Milton office.

"The goal of the program is to assist family members in coping more effectively with the relative who has a schizophrenic disorder," said Halton medical officer of health, Dr. Graham Pollett.

The aim of the program is to provide information, reduce anxiety, increase ability to cope with the affliction, and also to provide a support network for family members.

Previously, said association supervisor Mae Vaivods, families had to seek support in Oakville,

Burlington or Hamilton. Weekly sessions, she said, cover a wide range of topics,

side effects; impact on the family; and community support.

At an upcoming session, she said, a presentation will be made by a support group called Friends of Schizophrenics. With chapters in Oakville and Burlington, she said there will be an opportunity to form a chapter in North Halton if the families wish it.

Vaivods said similar six-week sessions will be arranged as the need arises.


Schizophrenia is a biological brain disease, characterized by impaired thinking, delusions, hallucinations and changes in emotions, behaviour and functioning.

Although affecting only 1 per cent of the population, the illness accounts for more than 50 per cent of all admissions to psychiatric facilities.

In about 25 to 30 per cent of the cases, the illness develops into a chronic longterm disorder.
