Minor peewees skate to 2-2 draw with Ching

The Halton Hurricane "AAA" Minor Peewee played host to Chinguacousy at Georgetown's Memorial Arena on Tuesday, as the two sides skated to a 2-2 tie.

The Hurricanes went into the game with two wins and a tie in their first three league contests. The small ice surface provided both sides an opportunity to demonstrate their skills at body contact, and demonstrate they did.

The first period, as billed, was a close checking hard hitting affair. Ching scored the only goal on a lob shot which deflected past a screened Jim Leworthy.

The second period saw the rear guards play a big part both offensively and defensively. Ryan Taylor, Colin Page, and Jonathan Atley pinched in several times to keep the pressure on in the Ching end. Tom Baynton and Jamie Briggs took advantage of some daylight to rush the puck well into the Chinguacousy zone, and late in the period a hard point shot by Paul Neff was intercepted by Todd Miller and the freshman

put one just inside the post to tie the game 1-1.

In the last seconds of the period, with Halton on a power play, Darin Finlayson sucked up a Doug Janjevich rebound but could not find the range before being pulled down.

The third period started with the line of Hartholt, Mashinter, and Miller striking early. Andrew missed on a 15 footer however Peter Mashinter fielded the rebound off the boards, passed out to Todd Miller, who scored his second of the game.

Two shifts later Ryan Taylor made a diving check to strip a breaking Ching winger of the puck. This set up a chance for Justin Davis who was thwarted by a great toe save from the spread eagled Ching goalie.

At 2:23 Chinguacousy tied the game on a broken play that left an undefended Ching forward a clear shot at the open net.

One minute later Jim Leworthy preserved the tie with a good pad save, robbing the Chinguacousy sniper of the go ahead goal.

Minor novice Hurricanes find Markham tough

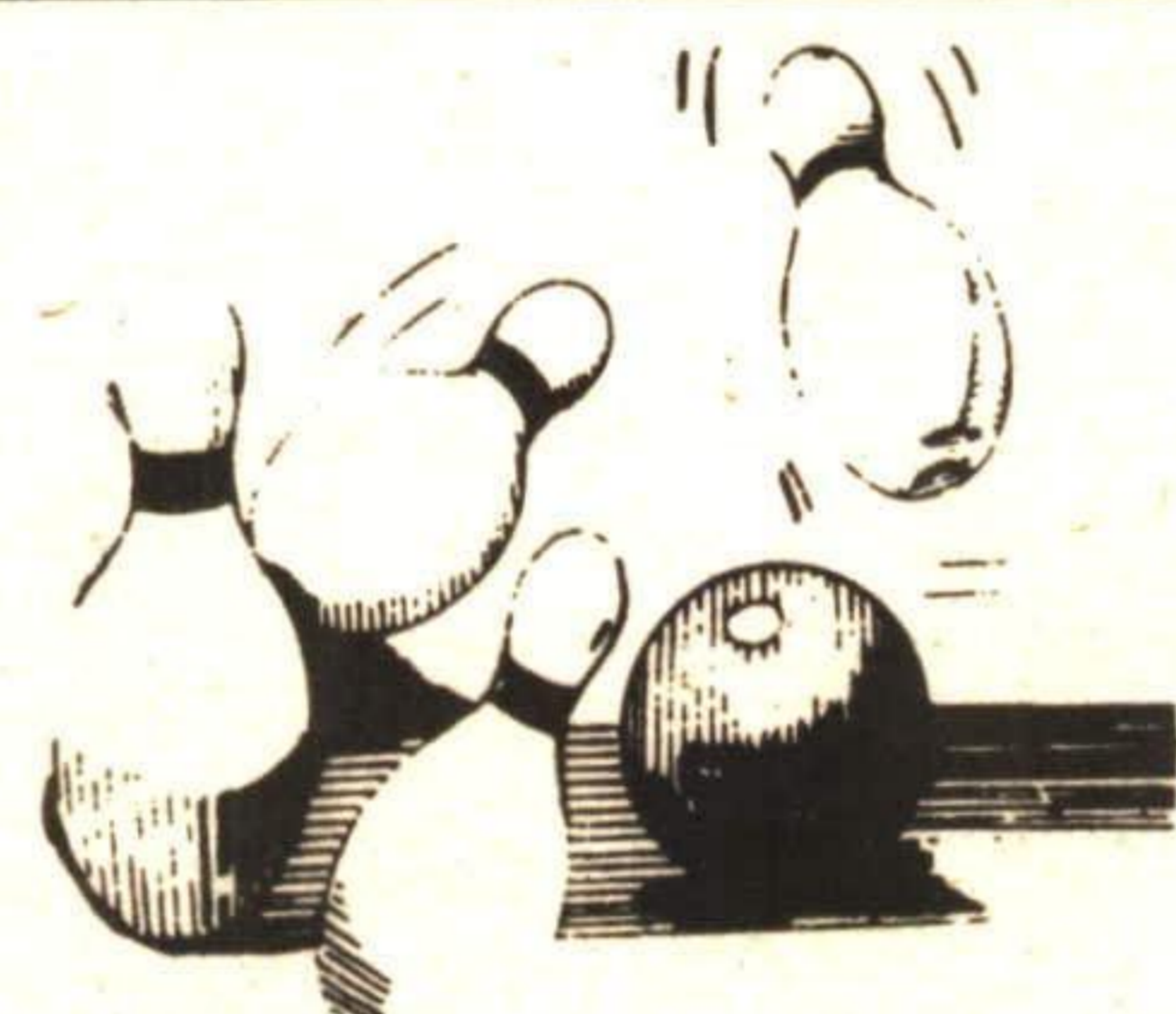

Halton was outshot 22-18 over the game, needing several key stops by goaltender Dylan Hardy early in the contest as the teams exchanged the lead.
