

# CVCA award goes to late Mayor Whillans

In an emotional ceremony at a meeting of the Full Authority, Edna Whillans, wife of the late chairman of the Credit Valley Conservation Authority and Brampton Mayor, Ken Whillans, accepted the CVCA's Award of Distinction for 1990 awarded in memory of Ken.

"We are proud to honor Ken for all his work over the years and this is just one small way we hope to do that," said CVCA Chairman Clark Glassford. Mr. Whillans drowned in a tragic accident near his Prince Edward Island summer home.

This is the fifth year of the Award of Distinction program. The award is presented each year to individuals, agencies and/or

corporate bodies who have made a significant contribution to natural resource management in the Credit River Watershed in the past.

"When it came to considering candidates for the award in September, Authority members suggested immediately the award be given in memory of Ken's commitment to natural resource management over the years," says CVCA Community Relations spokesperson Robert Peace.

Mrs. Whillans was joined by her son for the presentation.

"Thank you for this, I know Ken really enjoyed working with everyone at the CVCA and I am sure he is looking down on all of us now," said Mrs. Whillans.

The bylaw is a result of a petition presented to council earlier this year by residents upset about the noise the trains create while going through town.

Shepard. Town Council is expected to make the zoning official once a final report is submitted by the Planning Department.

## Restaurant approved

A new restaurant on Mill St. in Acton received the green light by Town Council Monday night. Following Mayor Russ Miller's suggestion, council reversed a staff recommendation to restrict the size of the restaurant due to parking limitations after hearing from owner Tim Bragg-Smith that the restriction would hurt the business. Bragg-Smith intends convert his home into a 1,600 square foot restaurant.

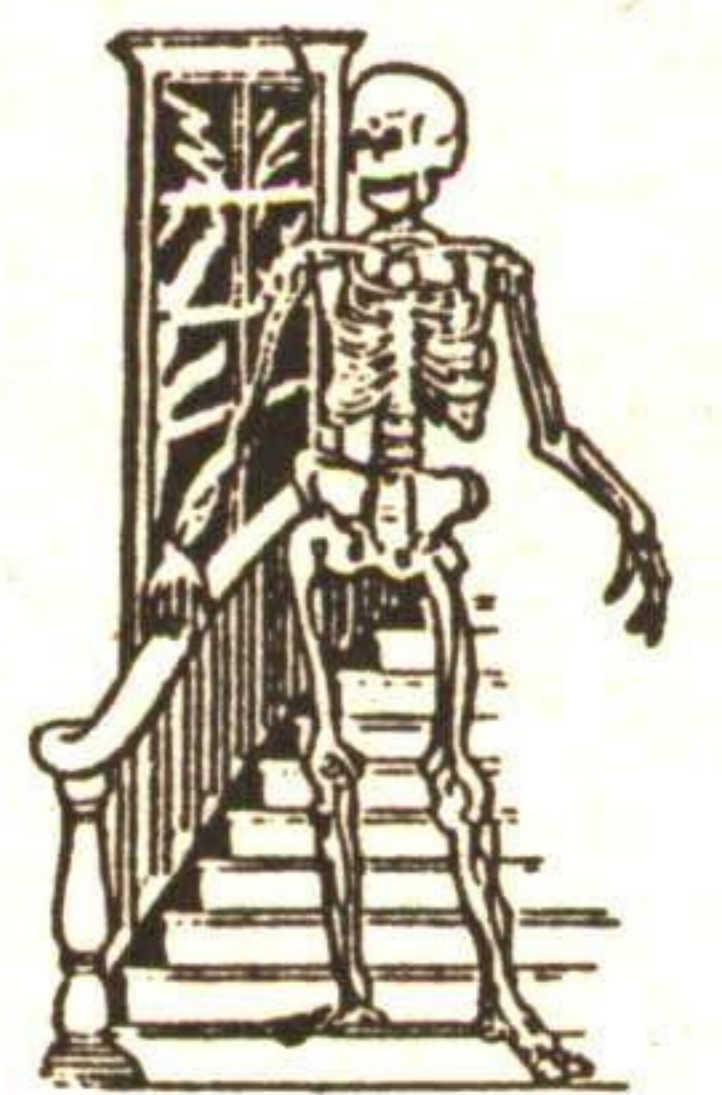

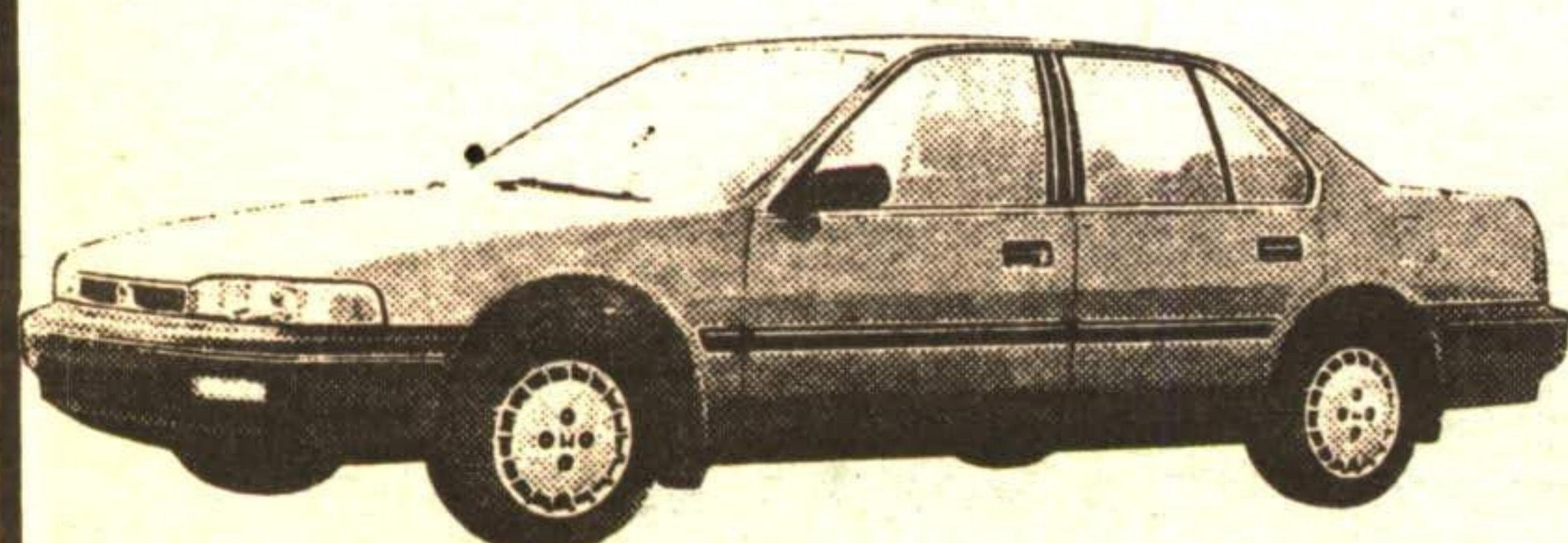
