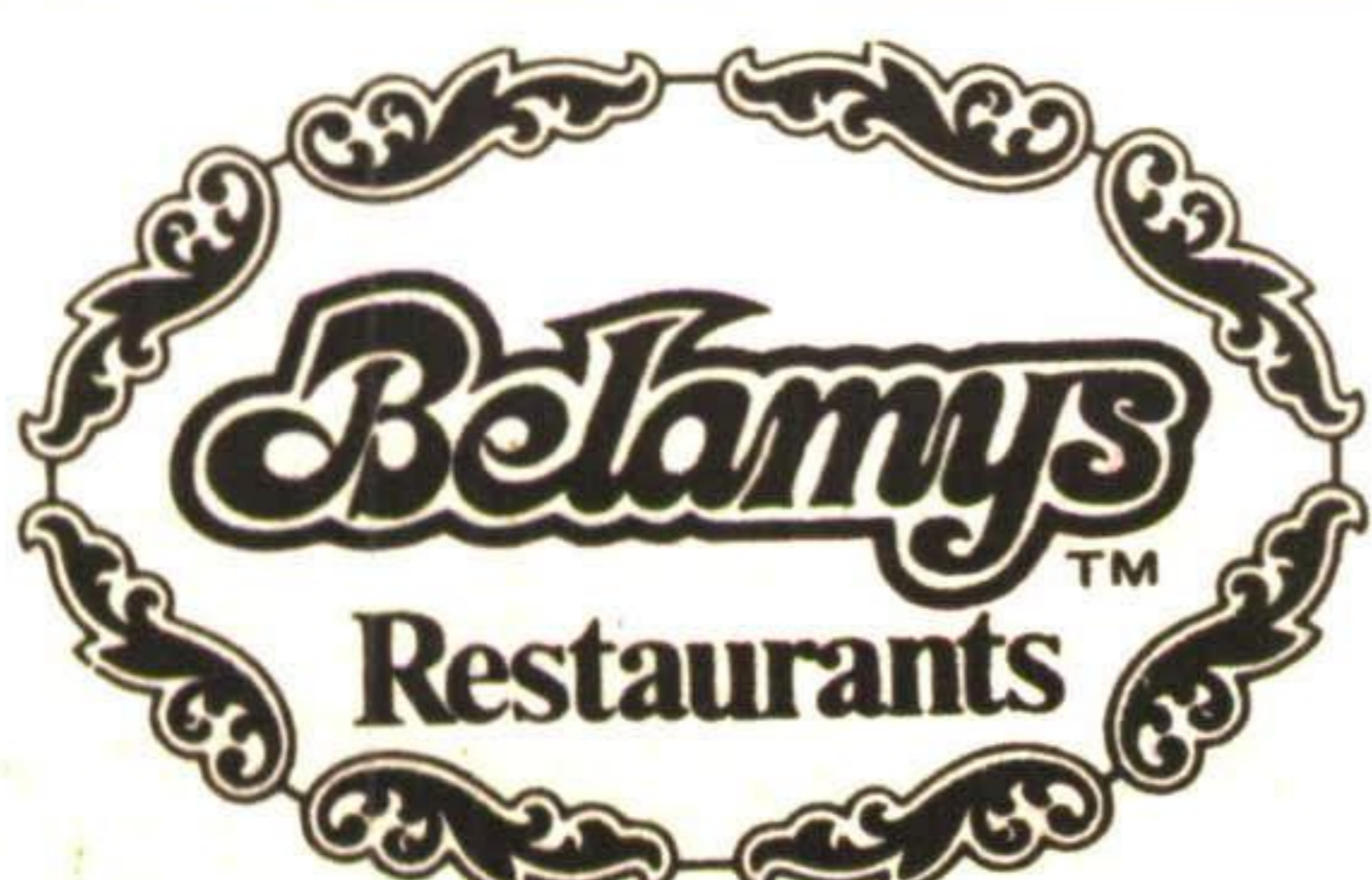

The joy of 'Misery'

Hollywood Beat

Another terrific pairing yet again! Rob Reiner last directed a Stephen King novel in 1986 with *Stand By Me* which turned into that year's sleeper hit and skyrocketed Reiner's directing career. Well Reiner has brought to the screen another King novel - *Misery* - and it's the absolute best cinematic adaptation of a King novel and Reiner's finest achievement in film.

Misery, with a screenplay by William Goldman (*Butch Cassidy, All The President's Men*) is a psychological thriller that'll leave you gasping for air in dire need of CPR. It stars James Caan as Paul Sheldon, an author whose best-selling novels based on a romantic heroine - Misery Chastain - have made him and his character folk heroes in American culture. But the constant demand for new *Misery* novels have pigeonholed Sheldon and left him somewhat jaded. To start writing what appeals to him, Sheldon finally decides to kill off Misery once and for all and begin a new chapter in his literary life.

After leaving his mountain-top writing retreat in Colorado, Sheldon then suffers a tragic car accident which leaves him unconscious and trapped in the middle of a blizzard. Fortunately for Sheldon, he's spotted and pulled from the wreckage by an adventurous passer-by who coincidentally turns out to be a nurse and Sheldon's "number-one fan." Anne Wilkes (Kathy

Bates) takes him home to her isolated mountain cottage and prepares to nurse him back to health. When Sheldon wakes up, he discovers he's suffering massive injuries to his legs and upper body, and unable to move, is forced to accept her help until the weather clears. His savior soon turns into his slayer as her insane obsession prevents him from leaving and results in a battle of wits between the physically incapacitated Sheldon and the mentally imbalanced Annie.

The ingeniousness of *Misery* is the simplicity and yet intricate terror woven throughout the film. The action takes part mostly in one small room and Caan is confined to just a bed and later wheelchair in the picture. But it's sheer brilliance. Caan delivers a stunning performance that bursts from the confines of his immobile character. Bates is simultaneously hysterical and on-the-edge horrifying. Reiner's ability to hone this film down to a bare essence and then extract a petrifying and frantic velocity is truly remarkable. If you haven't been thrilled to pieces at the movies lately, then *Misery* is the film for you.

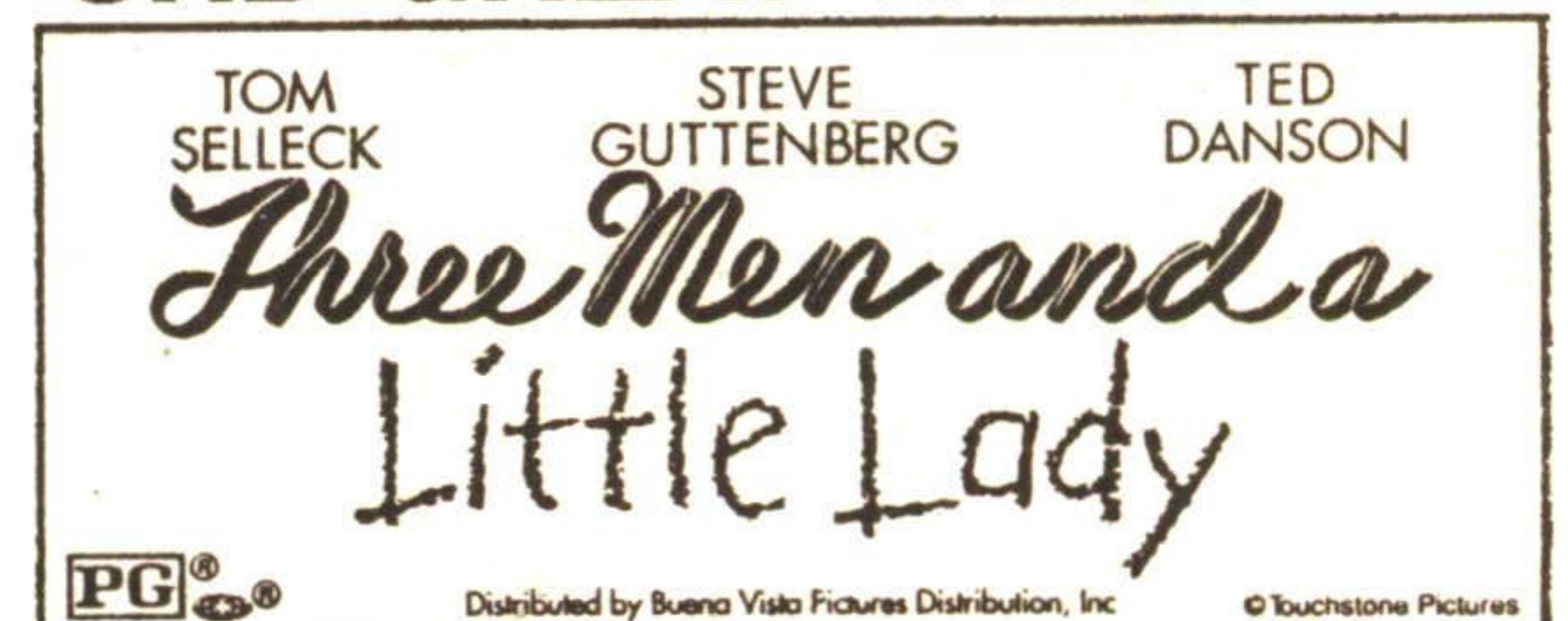
