Nissan NX: 'Organic' shape for the '90s

If you can't beat 'em, join 'em. After five years hoping it was just a fad, both Nissan and Toyota have bowed to the inevitable and are bringing out or are testing their own micro-GT to counter

Honda's wildly successful CRX.

People love or hate the CRX. A cop once told me all he had to do was see a CRX going the other direction, wait a minute or two, and then turn around and follow it for a sure-fire speeding ticket.


With its light weight, TWO plus two seating, more than willing multi-valve engine and racecar-inspired suspension, driving a CRX is fun on a budget. You can make your way through a lot of holes that just aren't there for drivers of bigger cars in a CRX, which is one of the reasons why people either love them or hate

Nissan has based its new NX1600 and NX2000 models on the newly-debuted Sentra. The NX used to be a model called the Pulsar, but that name has been dropped so people will think of this vehicle as a micro-GT, not a coupe cut from lowly econobox cloth.

Well it certainly has all the right things going for it starting with the shape of the body. You know this is a Nissan without being told from its "organic" styling, particularly the nose treatment reminiscent of the 300

ZX supercar. With body aero cladding, the "must-have" large spoiler, and front air dam sculpted to hold a pair of unnecessary fog lights, the test car came in see-me-OPP red. In fact, an unmarked OPP cruiser did decide to pace me at one point during the test, finally pulling away to go after (it's true) a CRX.

The NX1600 comes with Nissan's 110-hp, 1.6-litre multi-valve while the NX2000 has the larger, 140-hp, 2.0-litre multi-valver. The test car was a 2000 featuring such goodies as a forged .crank with eight counter weights to reduce vibration. Hit the gas on this front-drive car and you find it wants to go to the right thanks to torque steer. Up in the 4000 rpm



Green Thumb Gardening

ANTHURIUMS

Anthuriums or as they are more commonly known; Flamingo Flower, are one of the most exotic looking flowers. Their flowers have a unique and unusual beauty. The flowers are usually large, red and heart-shaped with a tail emerging from the top of the flower. It may not sound very attractive but, it really is. For some reason we usually associate unusual plants with difficult culture. However, in this case it is not true. Flamingo Flower and in particular Anthurium Scherzerianum is particularly easy to grow. They have long, spade-like leaves that radiate out from the centre of the plant. They are surprisingly thick and stiff even though they do not appear so at a distance. Once the plant begins to bloom it will produce a flower every time a new leaf develops. However, this does not mean that the plant will have only one flower at a time. As a plant ages it seems to develop multiple crowns or growing points, so many new leaves and flowers can be coming all the time. Each flower lasts at least a month. And the plant flowers years round but more abundantly in the summer months. A regular application of fertilizer is recommended, particularly when it is growing and flowering during the summer months. The only secret that I have found in successfully growing this plant is providing adequate humidity. One of the easiest ways of doing this is to place the pot it is growing in into a larger pot and pack shredded peat moss between the two pots. When kept moist it will provide extra humidity to the plant. Anthuriums are also one of the few plants that like to be kept constantly moist, they do not appreciate drying out between waterings.
