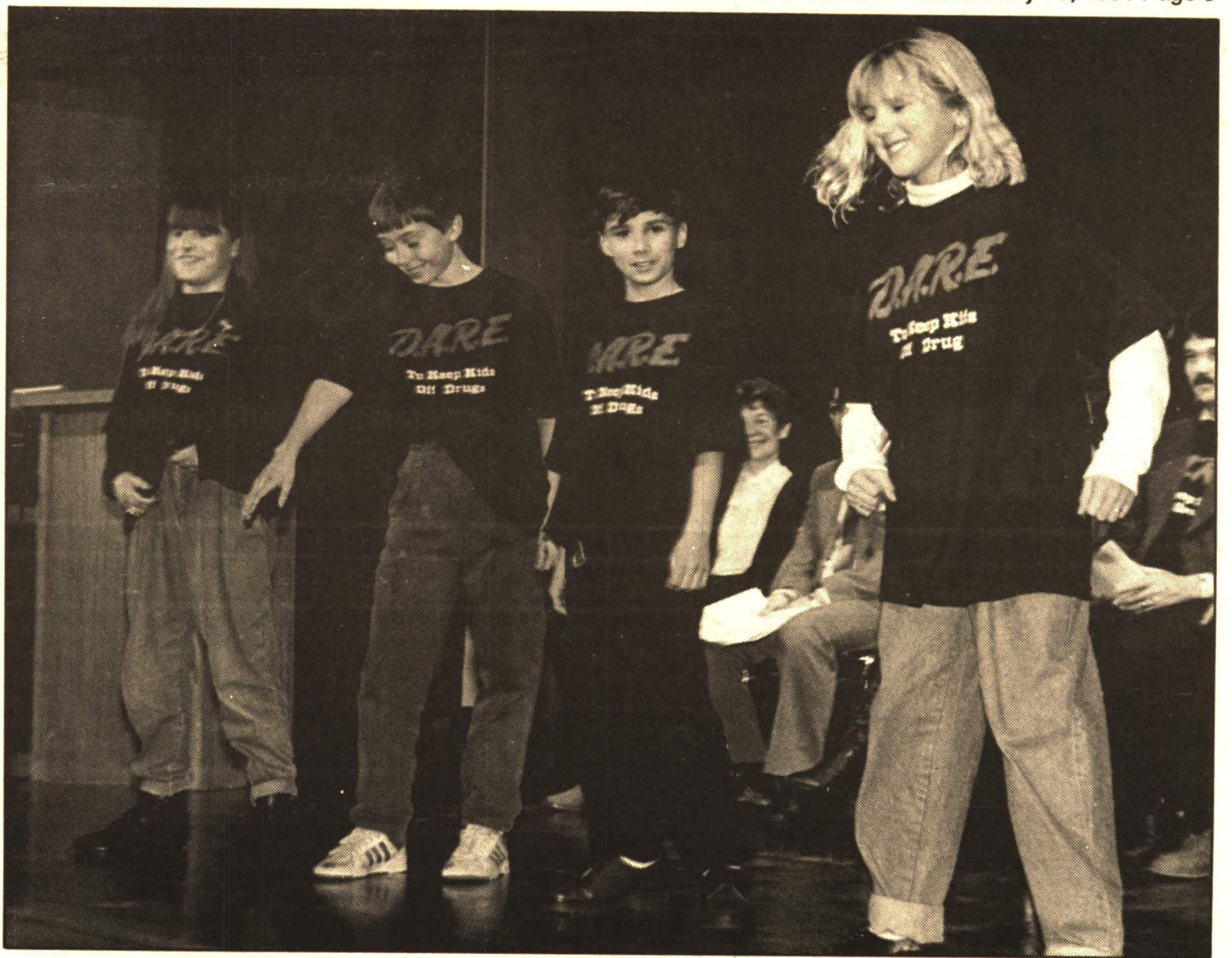




DARE to be drug-free
