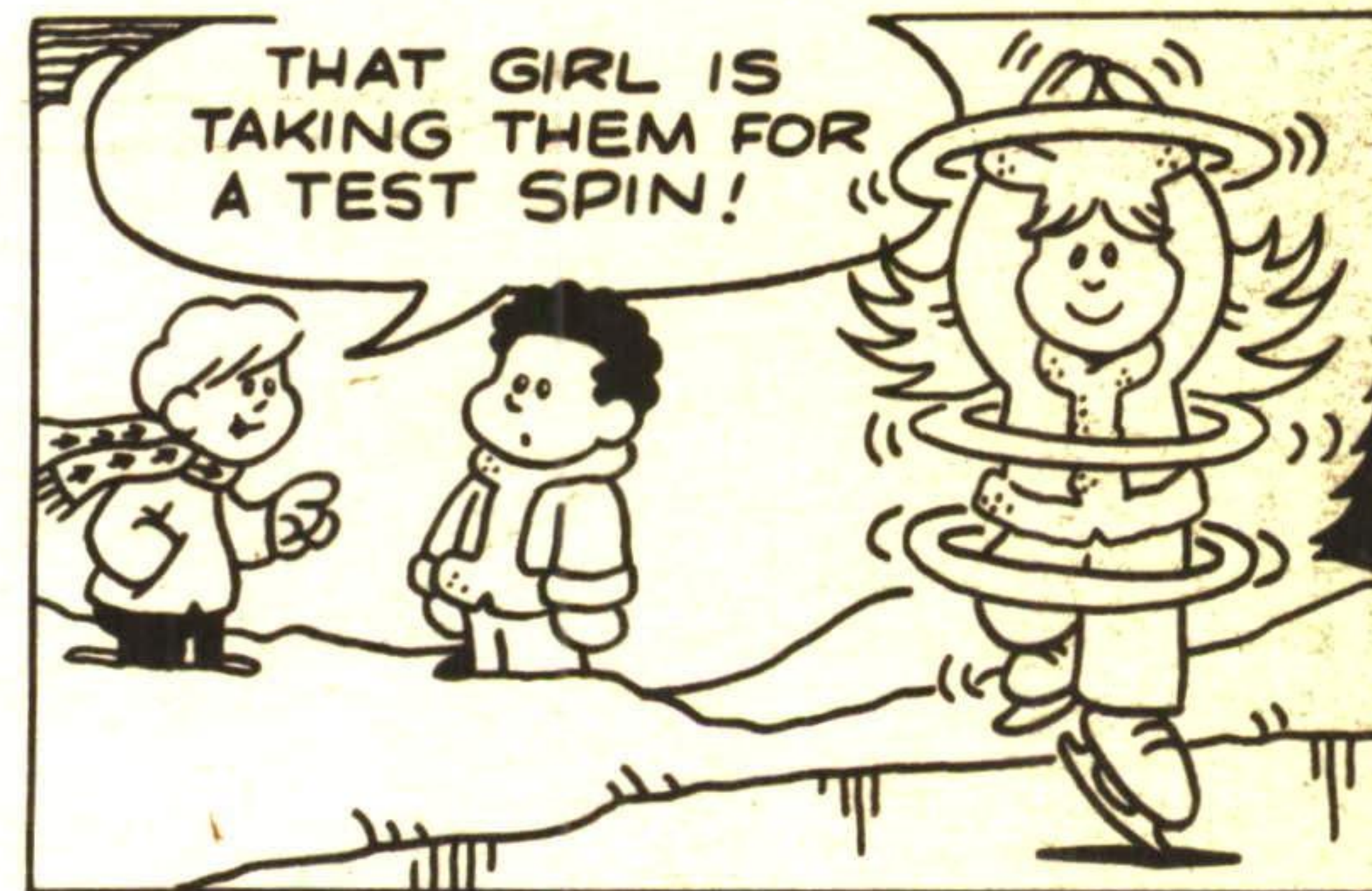

Bikes for CAS kids

What does a bicycle mean to a child? A bike can mean freedom, the opportunity to visit friends and places that might otherwise be inaccessible, a way to fit in when "all the other kids have bikes." At Halton Children's Aid Society, bikes are one of the most common "extras" requested by children in care. Unfortunately, financial restraints often mean that these requests cannot be filled.

Curt Gwisdek and Mauro Orlandi of Cycle Path bikes in Oakville know how important a bike can be to a child, especially one without too many material possessions. They organized an ambitious campaign to collect donated bikes from their customers to give to children in need at Christmas.

"The response was phenomenal - we got over 120 bikes," Gwisdek says, "but some of them were just junk. We were able to salvage parts from most of them,

though, and put together about 40 good, working bikes."

Gwisdek and Orlandi worked with Alexander Manson and other members of the Oakville Cycling Club to repair and clean up the bikes, then offered them to Big Brothers, Big Sisters and the Halton Children's Aid Society.

CAS Social Worker Don Neill says, "I was very impressed by what they had done. They had obviously put a lot of work into getting these bikes into condition, and it's been very exciting for the kids who got them."

Supervisor Marilyn Medjuck comments, "Another aspect that we think was very important is the terrific treatment that the kids were given when they went over to choose their bikes. The Cycle Path staff were generous with their time and genuinely eager to help them."

Gwisdek hopes to make this an on-going project, thanks to the enthusiasm of everyone involved.

University of Guelph sets up in Mississauga

Education when and where it's needed - that's the mandate of the University of Guelph's division of continuing education. In keeping with that mandate, University of Guelph certificate programs are now available in Mississauga.

"We noticed that several people were travelling to Guelph from Mississauga to take our courses and we realized it might be helpful to offer our courses there," says Virginia Gray, chair of Guelph's continuing education division. "We believed that even more people would appreciate an opportunity to take university-level continuing education courses in their own community."

Participants in University of Guelph certificate programs benefit from practical learning experiences that relate to real-world situations," says Remo Petrongolo, a continuing education program manager.

Course participants have opportunities to network with people of similar professional backgrounds and, through the

university's affiliation with professional groups and associations, can get involved in a number of accreditation programs. For example, Guelph's personnel courses are recognized by the Human Resources Professionals Association of Ontario and can be applied towards its certificate in personnel management.

Guelph's winter 1991 Mississauga schedule includes courses in human resources administration, effective writing and organization management, beginning Feb. 4. Three other courses - the fundamentals of human communication, employment law and introductory French - start Feb. 6. Two courses are also available by distance education - the fundamentals of human communication and managing people at work.
