Council approval imminent for Fourth Line subdivision, despite environmental concerns

Halton Hills Council is expected next week to give final approval for a 18-lot estate subdivision in rural Halton Hills — despite concern the development may abut an Environemntally Sensitive Area.

Located on a 19.33 hectare (47.7 acre) site on the Fourth Line between Hwy. 7 and the Halton Hills-Erin Township boundary, the development was the subject of a November public meeting.

Councillor Pat McCarthy suggested the approval be deferred until "differences" between the Town and Halton Region's definition of an ESA and the Credit Valley

Conservation Authority's definition were clarified.

According to town planner Glen Wellings, "the Town's and Region's ESAs are somewhat different that the CVCA's...(and) we're not sure why there is that discrepancy."

A clarification of the difference is expected at next week's council meeting before the development by Sette Investments is given approval.

Meanwhile, the planning department report said "there were some questions/concerns raised" at the public meeting in November.

Chief concern among area residence was the "preservation of

exisiting water quality and quantity," the report released at the general committee meeting of Halton Hills Council said.

Councillor Norm Elliot supported the residents' concerns adding he was "more concerned about the exisitng wells that I am about the new ones."

But at the public meeting a hydrogeologist for the developer "indicated there is ample water to support this proposal," the planning deparment report said.






