

# Hat trick just the start for AAA's Todd Miller

Last weekend the Halton Minor Peewees went on the road to Hamilton's Scott Park arena.

Halton left the steel city with an 8-3 victory and Hurricane centre Todd Miller had contributed three goals and three assists to the cause.

In the second, Colin Page started it off scoring a shorthanded goal, once again set up by Miller. This was followed with an unassisted marker from Janjevich at 3:57.

Hamilton managed to squeeze one in with just 23 seconds left in the period then it was Miller with the hat trick at 6:46 of the third, set up by Jamie Briggs.

Curtis Carr was the closing act,

scoring Halton's eighth at 5:38 assisted by Mashinter and, you guessed it, Miller.

Not a bad day at the rink for Mr. Miller. Six points, a hat trick, and two points for the team.

On Tuesday evening, the Minor Peewees returned home to face Barrie at Alcott arena.

Regrettably, the script had been rewritten and it was Barrie going north with the win.

This was the fourth meeting this season between Barrie and Halton and all four have been decided by one goal and gone late into the third before the final outcome could go to print.

The visitors opened the scoring at 1:26 of the first and again at 14:09 of the second.

Halton replied at 13:17 on a Justin Davis goal assisted by Steven Roy only to have Barrie strike again just 13 seconds later to reestablish the two goal lead.

Later in the period, the Hurricanes made it 3-2 on Darin Finlayson's goal set up by Davis, but solid goaltending by Barrie protected the lead into the third.

The visitors added two more midway through the last frame to stretch their lead to three and Todd Miller's goal at 1:46 assisted by Curtis Carr and Peter Mashinter, along with Davis' second of the game from Miller at the 50 second mark were not enough to pull it out.

These teams will meet twice more over the next two weeks and the outcome will probably decide second place in the Central Division.

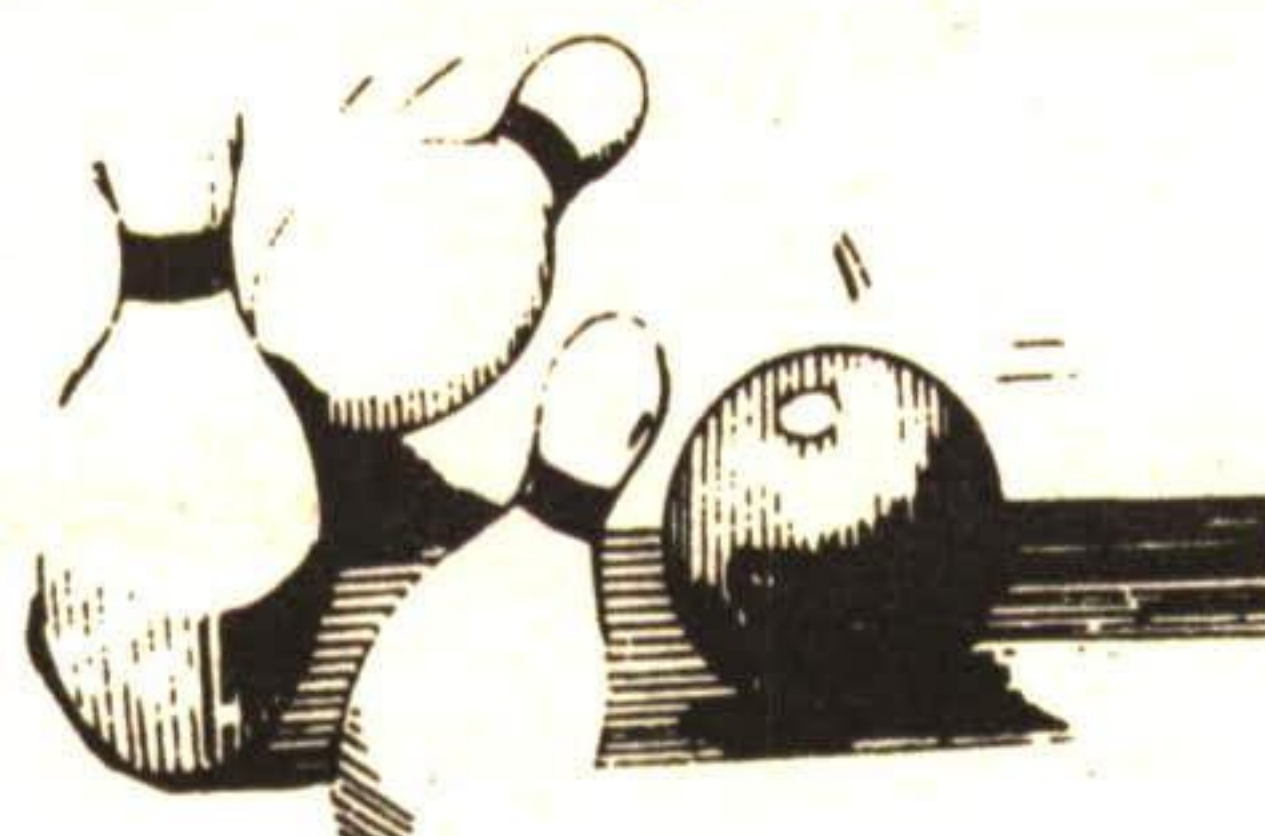
town ahead 3-1.
