Theatre Sheridan will present the third production in the 1990-91 mainstage season; *What Glorious Times They Had - Nellie McClung*; a loosely knit, uproariously funny satire about the struggles of Nellie McClung and the suffragists, in their efforts to win the vote in pre-First World War Manitoba.

The play depicts "nice middle-class ladies" trying to change women's lot in life, and is portrayed with liberal amounts of humor, music and vitality. Combining the themes of politics, pro-

hibition and suffrage makes for a fast-moving, free-wheeling evening's entertainment.

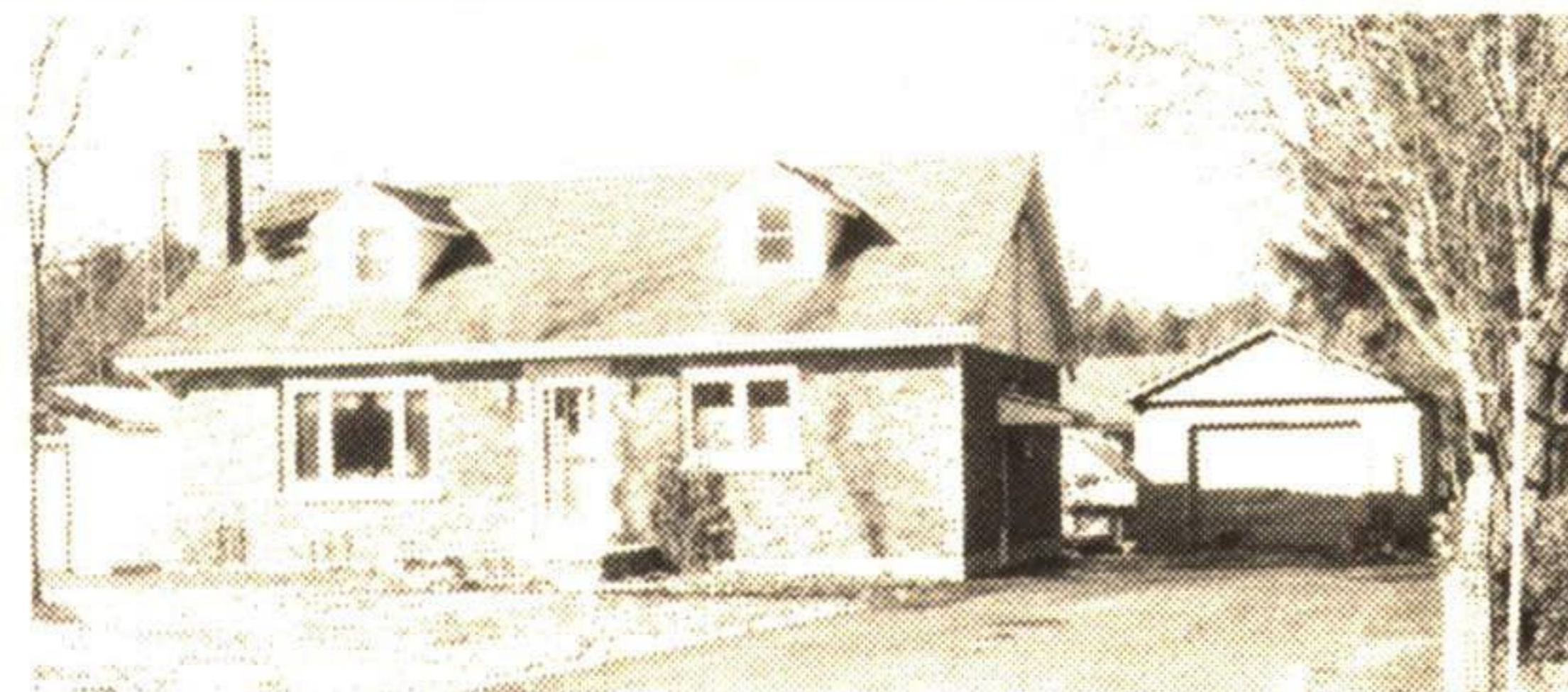

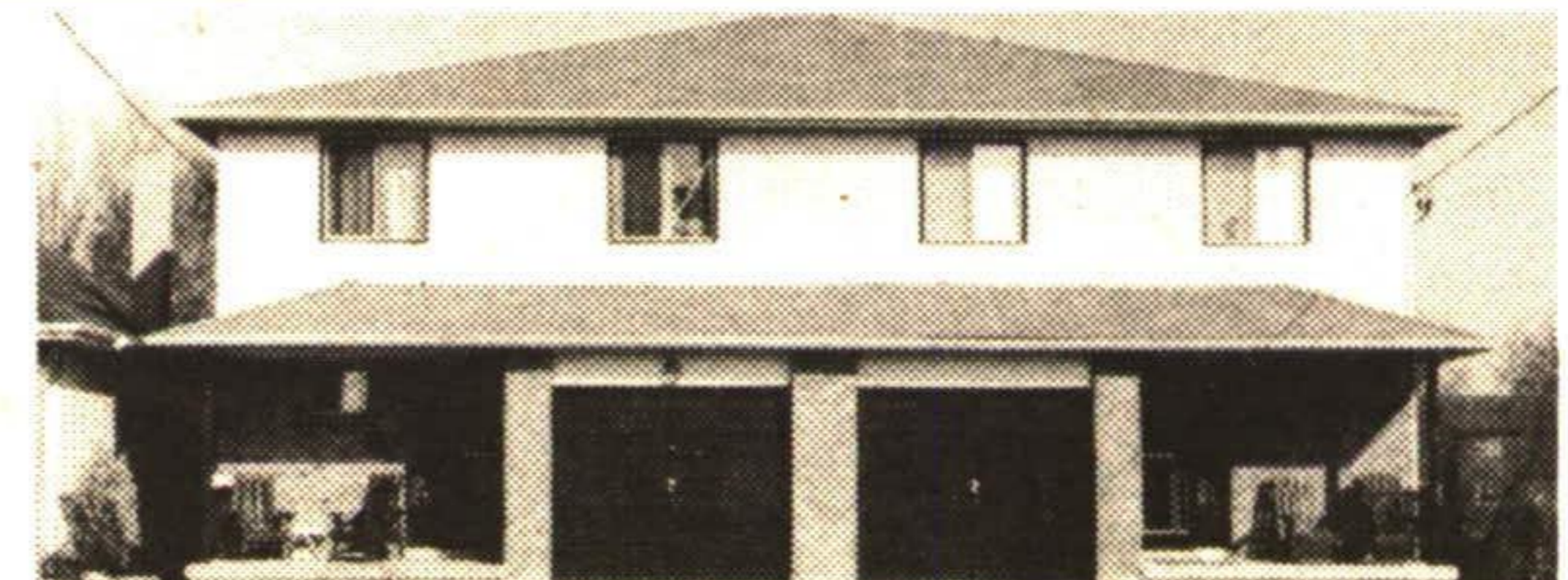
