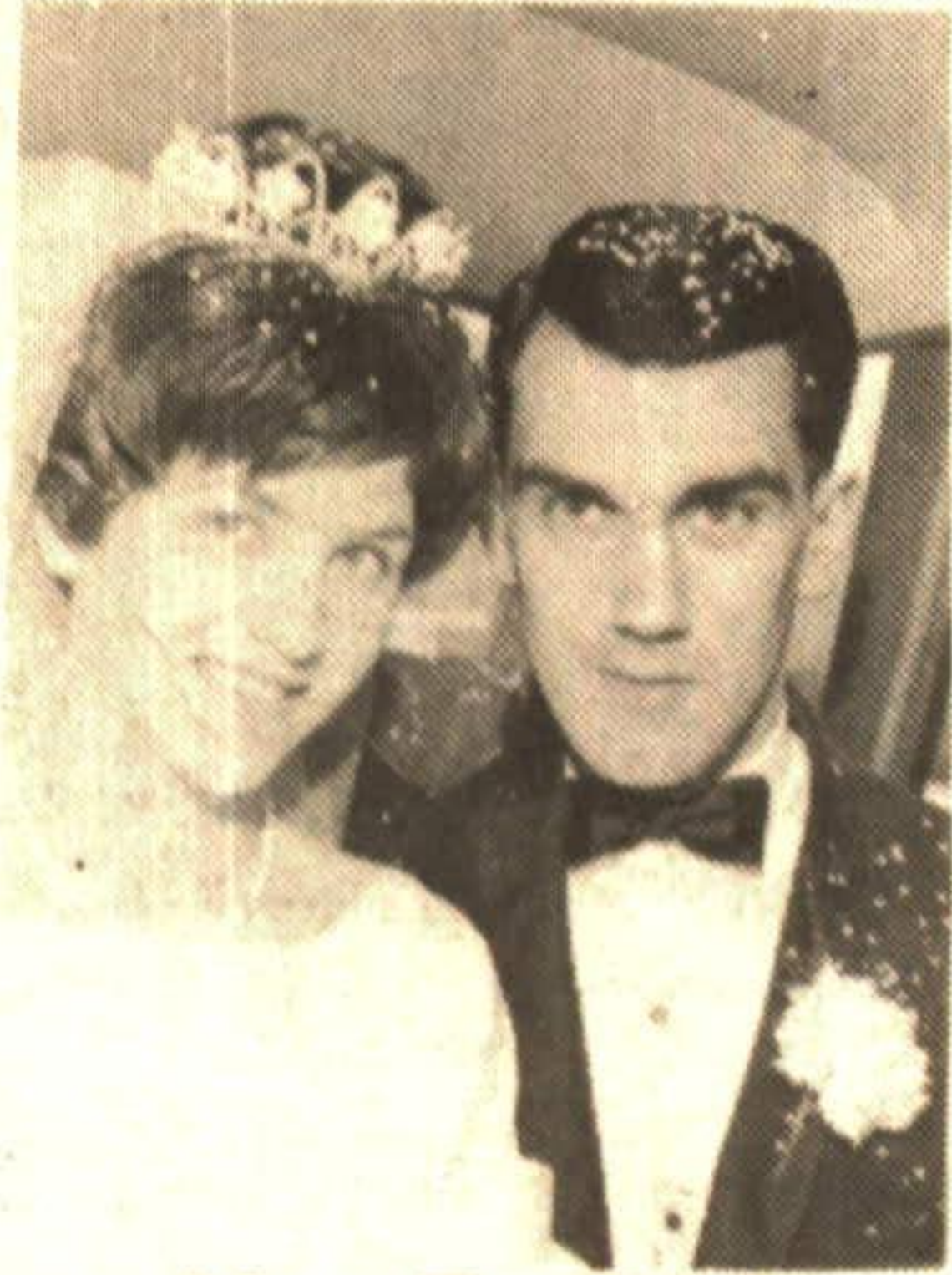

Crimestoppers

Police seek assistance in daylight ring thefts

The Halton Regional Police and Crime Stoppers of Halton are seeking information that will lead to the arrest of the persons responsible for a series of daring, daylight thefts, from two Oakville jewellery stores.

On April 16, 1991, a suspect, described as male white, approximately 25 years of age, with long light brown hair down to the middle of his back, with a light moustache, and otherwise clean shaven, entered the "Peoples Jewellers" store in the Oakville Place Mall. This man was dressed in a grey tweed jacket, brown dress pants, beige dress shirt, a dark brown tie and dark brown loafers.

The culprit engaged the store clerk in a discussion about two very expensive ladies' and men's diamond rings. Once the rings were removed from the display case the culprit grabbed them and fled from the scene.

The culprit was followed to a waiting vehicle described as a small car, two-door, red in color, possibly a Honda Civic or Firefly. This vehicle had a driver and another passenger. A second vehicle was seen parked with this get-away car and it fled the scene at the same time as the red car. It is described as a white, four-door, vehicle similar to a Sen-

tra. There were two occupants in this second vehicle.

Earlier in the year, on March 22, a similar theft occurred at the "Mappins Jewellers" store, also at Oakville Place Mall. Police investigators believe that same culprits are responsible.

A total of four rings were stolen, with an inclusive value of \$35,950.

The rings are described as follows:

1) A 14 carat, yellow gold ladies' solitaire diamond ring. Serial number 239 etched inside the band. Valued at \$9,650.

2) A 14 carat, yellow gold, ladies' solitaire diamond ring. Serial number 45 etched inside the band. Valued at \$6,700.

3) A 14 carat, yellow gold, ladies' solitaire diamond ring. Serial number 39 etched inside the band. Valued at \$8,000.

4) A 14 carat, yellow gold gentleman's diamond dress ring. Serial number 301 engraved inside the band. Valued at \$11,650.

If you have any information that leads to an arrest in this or any other case, you may be eligible for a cash reward. You need not give your name and your call will be treated with complete anonymity. Please call 1-800-668-5151.

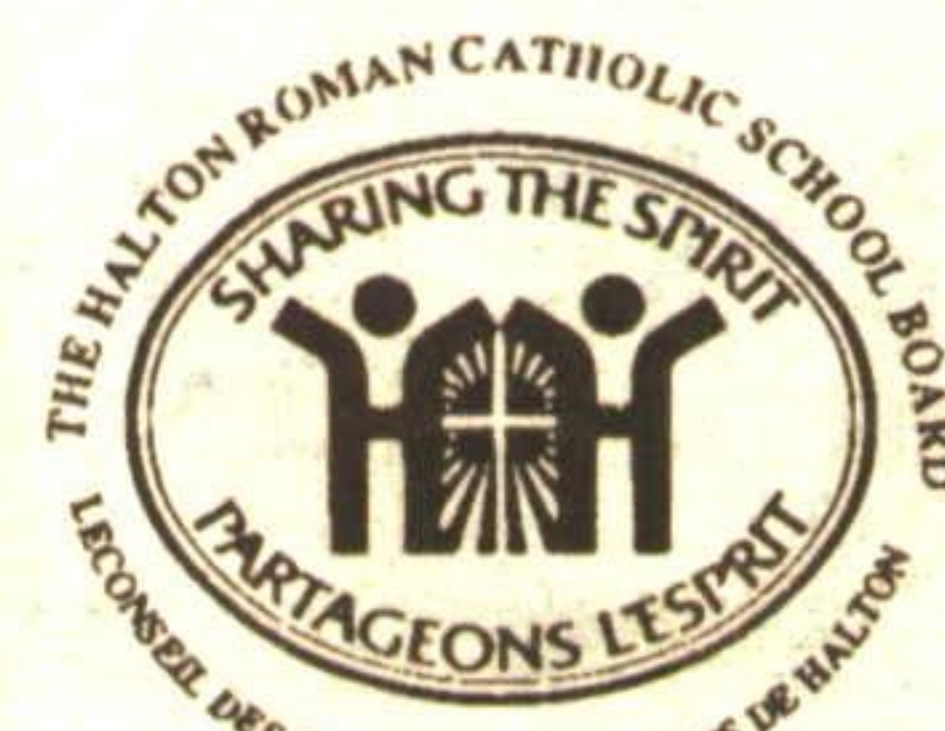
