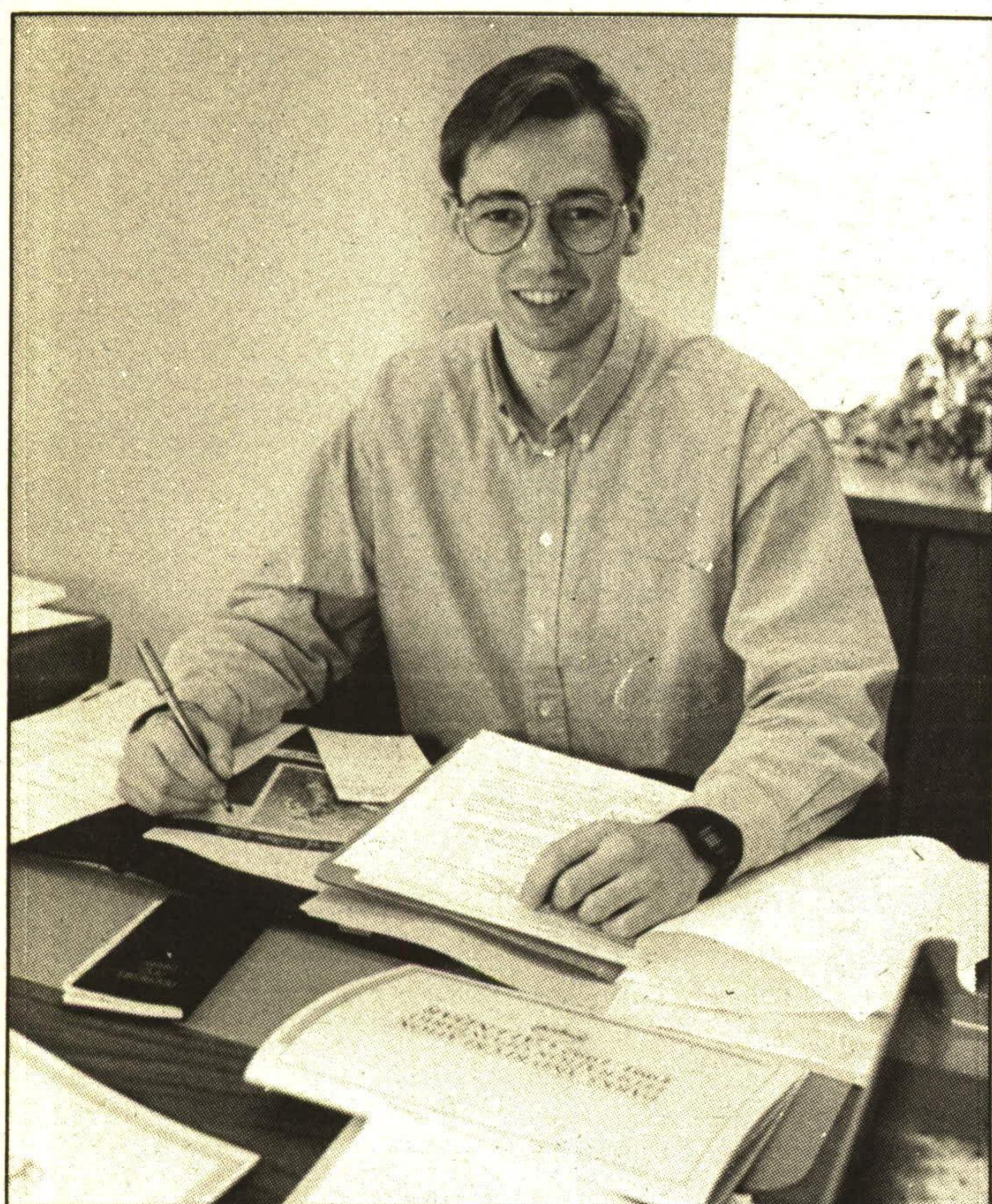
"We're giving businesses the opportunity to come in and talk to staff," Miller said. "If they have questions about the process, maybe they want to expand their business — these will be answered."
