

Weapons decision appealed

A Limehouse business has decided to appeal a court decision on guns it had for sale.

The Provincial court decided last month that 24 Heckler and Kosh MP5-A3 rifles which had been imported from England are prohibited weapons. The guns were seized from Collector's Source in January,

The guns were converted into semi- automatic mode so they could be legally sold in Canada. But the Halton Regional Police contend they can be readily converted back into automatic weapons, which fire 800 rounds of ammunition a minute.

The guns were being sold by Collector's Source for \$1899, but

now all 24 will have to be destroyed, so Collectors Source stands to lose thousands of dollars.

Morton Greenglass, the lawyer for Collectors Source, contends he has the upmost respect for the judge, but he thinks he has made the wrong decision.

Greenglass said that a prohibited weapon is "capable of firing more than one round" when the trigger is pulled, but when these weapons were seized, the guns were only capable of firing one round, he said.

"It's not like everybody tries to make it out, that all a person has to do is take a trip into Buffalo" to get a new part and convert the gun, Greenglass said. The parts aren't available to people, he said.

Mike Eacrett, head of the Criminal Investigations Bureau in Georgetown, said he isn't surprised that the decision is being appealed. But, he said he thinks the decision will be upheld.

The appeal date has been set for September 12, 1991 in Toronto.

Collector's Source is not to be confused with Frank Grant's museum of military memorabilia, also located in Limehouse.
