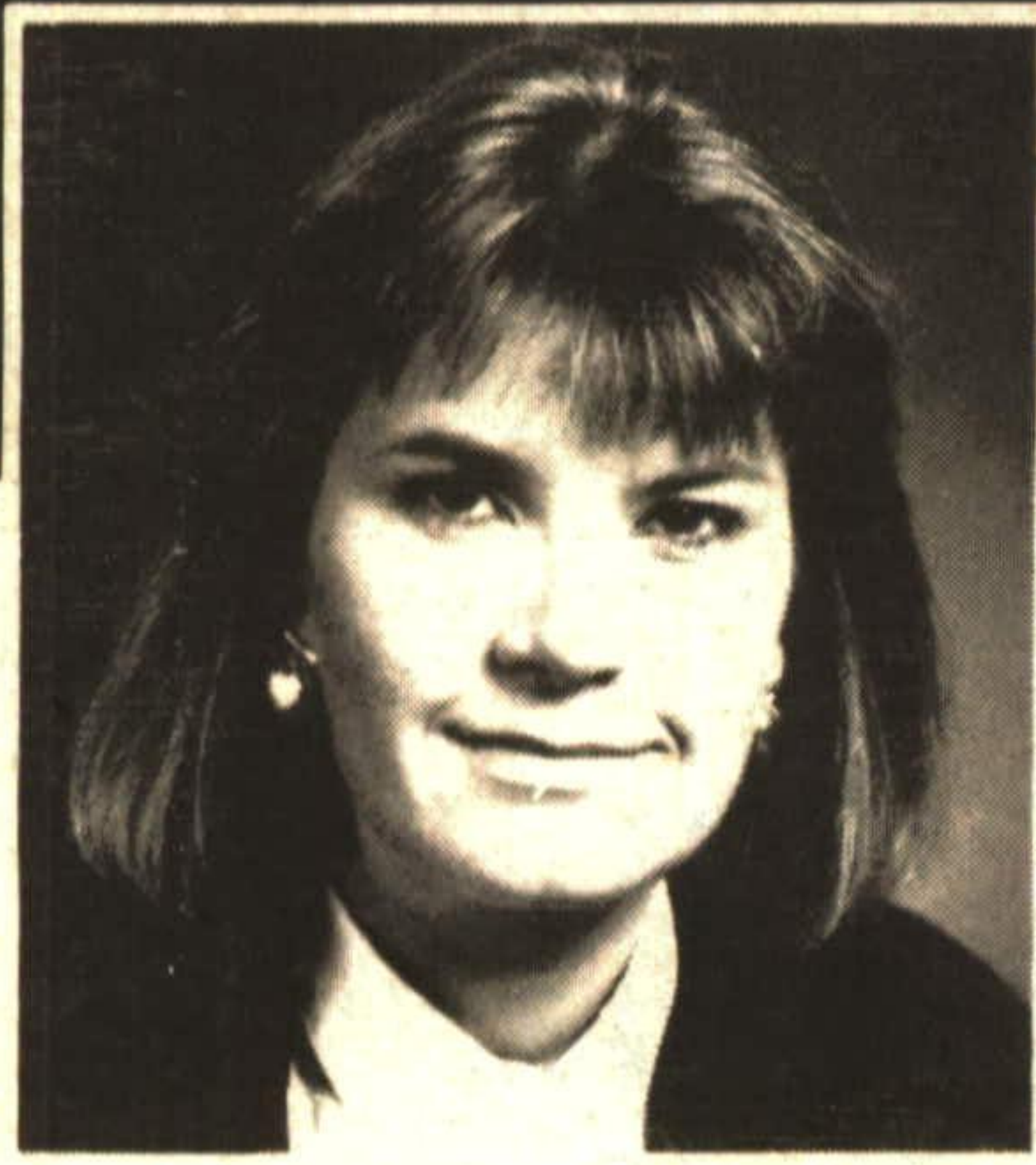
Suspect wanted

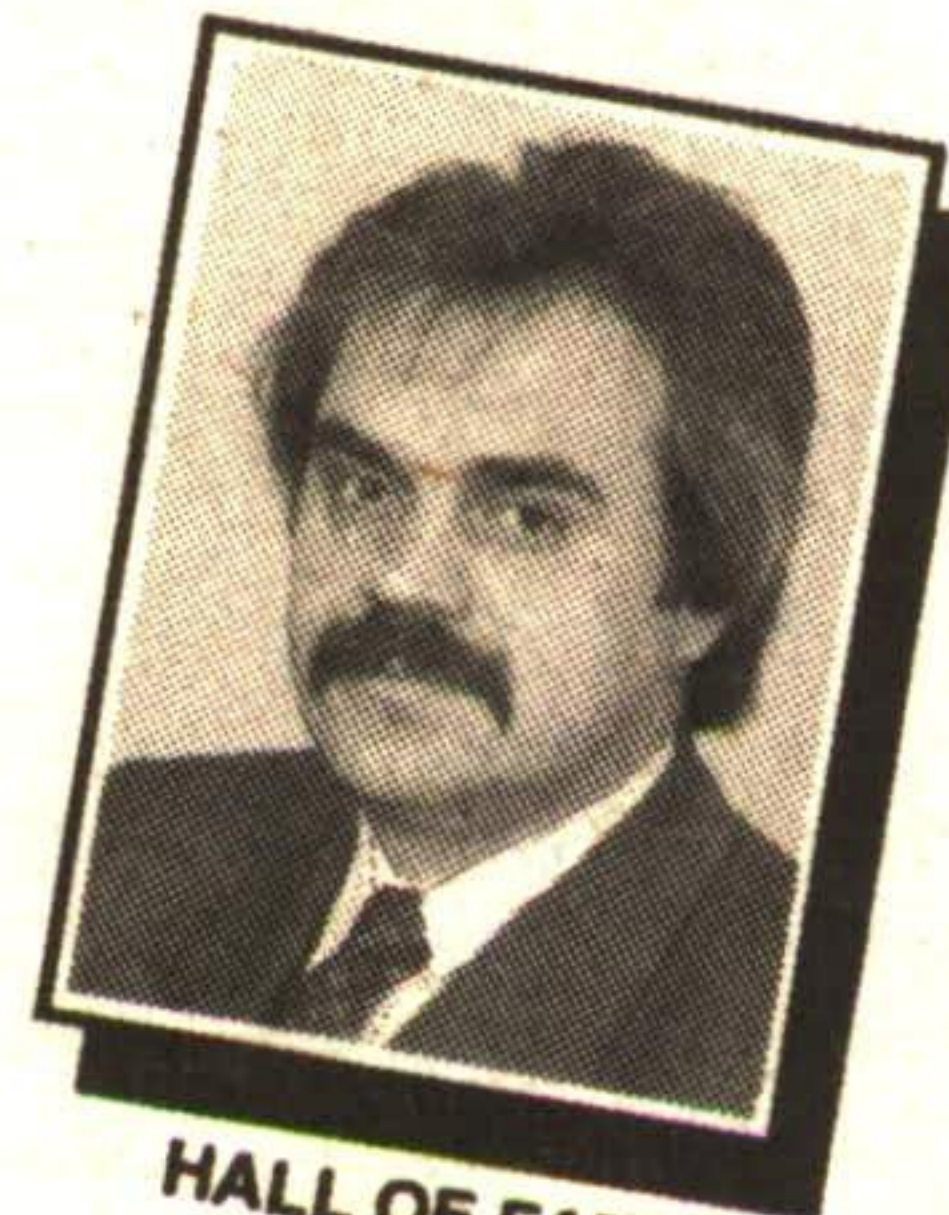
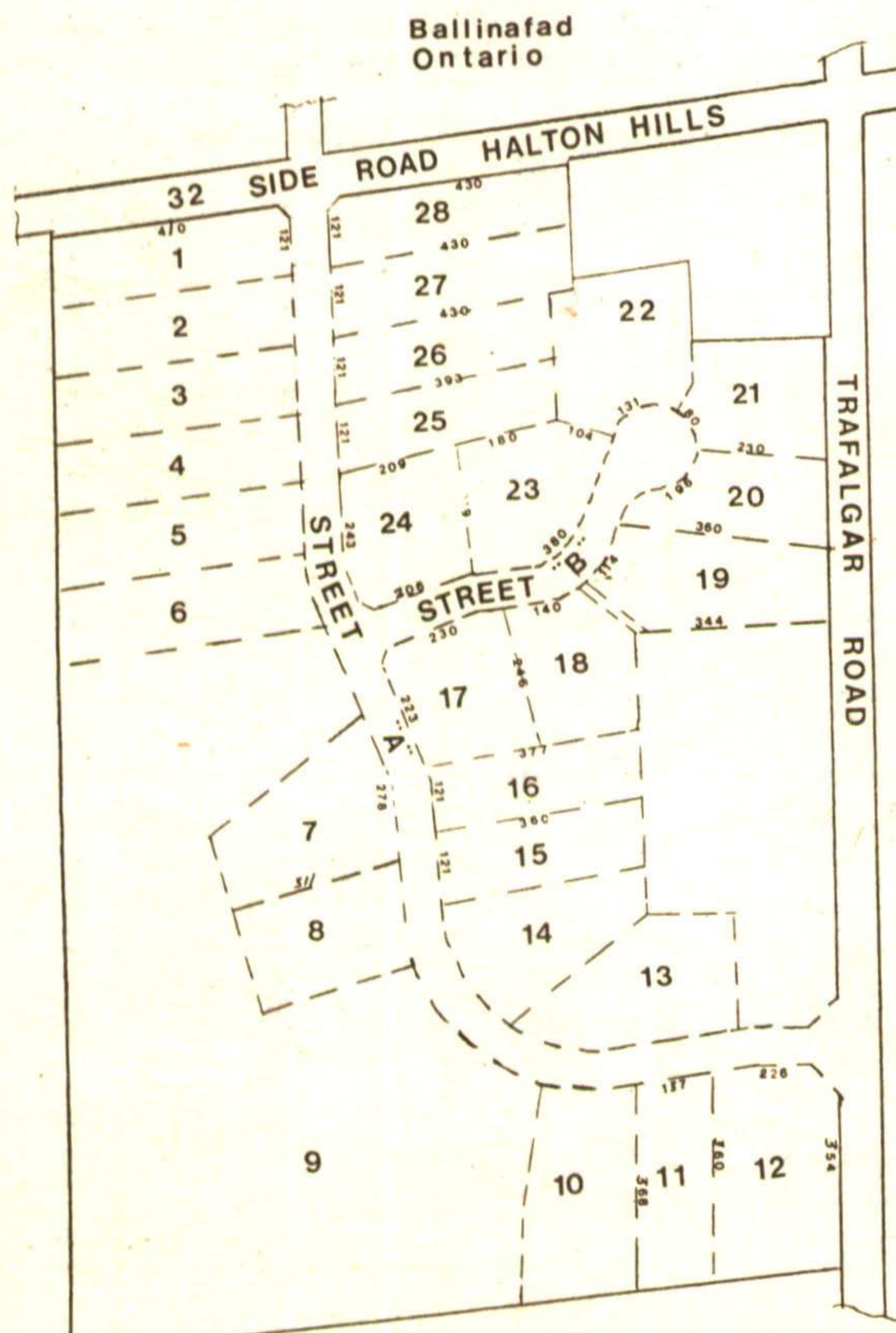
