'The Little Stinker' creates a big stink

I'll never forget my first encounter with a striped skunk. PHEW! I was about to put out the trash late one night and as I lifted the garage door a skunk, only a few months old, ran out from behind the garbage bags and darted between my legs. During his escape however, the little stinker lifted his tail and let loose a bad smelling odor.

quickly ran into the house, stripped off my smelly clothes and jumped into the shower. My eyes began to sting and my stomach became upset from the foul smell. Days later I still stunk of skunk, even after bathing in vinegar and tomato juice. A month later the smell finally went away but the little stinker still remained living in my garage.

I tried every type of trap to capture the skunk but he escaped every time. It soon became obvious we had to learn to live together.

spray or if he was just bluffing. I waited out his bluff until he waddled away from the garbage bags.


The skunk can either spray in a fine mist or with a direct squirt, hitting objects as far as 16 feet away. But it only sprays if startled and has no way to escape. The sight of a skunk's raised tail is usually enough to chase away any animal. In fact, the skunk's powerful scent gland, about the size of a grape and located in the anus, is so nauseating that the skunk will try desperately not to spray itself.

The gland, which makes the smell, holds about one tablespoon of an oily liquid, enough to produce half a dozen sprays. To get a better aim, some skunks will spray while doing a headstand or bend into a U-shape, with its head and little shooter pointing the same way.

The striped skunk has few predators due to its defensive system, but it does not render it safe from attack. The skunk's main predator is the Great Horned owl. I remember years ago while working at Mountsberg Wildlife Centre where I cared for injured birds of prey, I looked after a Great Horned. It had dined on skunk before its injury and it sure didn't make my job any easier.

Skunks are omnivorous, meaning they eat virtually anything that comes their way. A wide variety of berries are included in their diet, as well as fruits, small mammals, birds' eggs and nestlings, young rabbits and frogs. Insects, however, are the most important part of their diet, especially hornets and bumblebees. They will scratch away at a hive and when the insects come out to fight off the intruder, the skunk will roll them between its front paws and stuff them in its

Skunks usually forage close to their den site and come winter will spend several cold months in a dormant state (they do not hiberate), sometimes joined by several other skunks for company.

The skunk still lives in my garage. She even got married last year and became a mother to a litter of little stinkers. Eventually we became friends. Our relationship is simple — I respect her space in the garage and she doesn't spray me every time we meet on garbage day.

It sure beats bathing in tomato juice!
