Green-lipped Mussel Extract -Initial studies by an Australian marine pharmacologist seemed to indicate that a compound made from this shellfish found off the coast of New Zealand had antiinflammatory properties. However, subsequent independent laboratory studies failed to duplicate the original results.

Herbal Remedies - In 1985, an independent consumers' watchdog group had 27 herbal remedies analyzed by a leading toxicology laboratory. The results showed

that none of them had any signifi-

cant beneficial effect, and many were potentially harmful. Increased or long-term consumption of herbal remedies can cause side effects such as stomach upset, diarrhea and nausea. Some of the herbs you should be wary of are devil's claw, elder and juniper berry, soap wart (saponaria), coltsfoot and lobelia. Be especially careful not to ingest aloe vera, essential oil of anise and Chuifong Toukuwan, a Chinese herbal tea.

Radon Health Mines - Promoters have been touting the benefit of sitting for repeated periods of time in abandoned radium mines that emit radon gases. Radon is a radioactive gas formed as a by-product of the atomic disintegration of radium. Despite extravagant claims and luxury tour packages to radon mines in the American midwest, radon therapy is totally unsubstantiated by scientific studies.

Tropical Oils and Cream -Massaging cod liver oil, or olive or peanut oil, into inflamed joints has been promoted as a pain remedy. There is no evidence to support these claims.

WD-40 - Made from petroleum distillates and extremely flammable, WD-40 is a maintenance product meant to protect metal from rust and dirt. Several reports of severe allergic reaction to the use of WD-40 on affected joints have been recorded. Breathing it into the lungs can cause chemical pneumonitis.




