"It was even more successful than we had hoped," said Dawn Kackley, one of the organizers of the event. She estimates 700 people attended the event, which ran from noon until dusk.






> Events included readings of poetry and fiction outside by the mill, at the Eden Mills Hotel, the Community Hall and Eden Place.




