Phil's Basement

Where did the summer go? We've just returned from a few days of holidays at a cottage that we've been renting since the twins were babies. Looking back over the last couple of months, I think we all enjoyed the summer — what there was of it, that is. Our son Kyle thoroughly enjoyed a couple of weeks at a baseball camp, his twin sister Belinda did some lifeguarding at a local pool, and Em and I got our kitchen renovations done.

Belinda and Kyle will be starting back to school soon, and we've all got to start getting organized in general for the fall. Part of my general organization involves going through all kinds of stuff in the basement and pitching out whatever I can. I came across a pamphlet from The Hydro that reminded me of the time Em thought I'd snapped when she found me dusting all the lightbulbs in the house. I told her that I'd just found out that dust-free lightbulbs and fixtures were a lot more energyefficient.

Anyway, this pamphlet has a lot of great information on energy-efficient lighting. In fact, Thomas Edison would be amazed to find out what's happened to his lightbulb lately. For instance, I recently bought a few 10-watt compact fluorescent bulbs that produce the same amount of light as a 60-watt incandescent bulb.

You can also save money and

energy by using lower wattage bulbs. For instance, a 25- or 40-watt incandescent (or 11-watt compact fluorescent) bulb would likely provide ample light for, say, your porch and could replace that 75- or 100-watt bulb you've probably got in there now. If you have dimmers, and you find you're always lowering the lighting to get the level you want, you could put lower wattage bulbs in those fixtures.

"Let the buyer beware!". It seems there are incandescent bulbs on the market called "long life" or extended life bulbs which do last a long time — 1,500 to 10,000 hours, compared to 750 to 1,000 hours for a normal bulb. But did you also know they use the same amount of energy while putting out up to 30 per cent less light?

Speaking of saving money, I know exactly what'll happen to the money we save with energy-efficient bulbs. "Mom!" I heard Kyle yell a little while ago from the depths of his closet, "None of my school clothes fit me!!"
