 The production is Opera Comique by Nagle Jackson, a farce with a difference. It's a costume production, set in 1875, and the setting is the opera house in Paris. The characters involved are:

Paul Vigneron: A distinguished gent, mid-40s. Hector Vigneron: Paul's son - a lecherous military cadet. Charles Gounod: Composer, in his mid-40s.

National Youth Orchestra's audition deadline Nov. 30

The National Youth Orchestra of Canada announced a November 30 deadline for receipt of all audition applications for the 1992 NYO session.
 Auditions are expected to be held from January 13 through January 17, 1992 in approximately 30 locations across Canada. In exceptional cases, applications from young musicians will be accepted up to the time auditions commence. In most regions, live auditions will be scheduled for applicants. Otherwise, students may audition by cassette.

 The National Youth Orchestra also announced the formation of a special scholarship program, to begin in 1992 sponsored by the Royal Bank of Canada.
