## OMAF office moves to Georgetown next month

Halton Hills farmers will have the offices of the Ontario Ministry of Agriculture and Food (OMAF) a little closer by the end of March.

Acting Halton Agricultural Representative Marie McNabb told this newspaper the OMAF office will be moved to 332 Guelph St. (the old Varian office) and the move would be made over the weekend of March 28-29. The office will be shutting down around 4 p.m. Friday (Mar.27) and re-opening at the new location Monday morning (Mar. 30).

The new office will serve both Halton and Peel regions, and Peel's agricultural representative Barry Sinclair will take over as agricultural representative for both regions.

McNabb will be staying on at the new location as one of two farm management specialists.

"I'll still be available to talk to anyone who wants help or information," says McNabb, "And I look forward to handling my new duties as farm management specialist."

The office has been located for several years at 17 Wilson Drive in Milton.

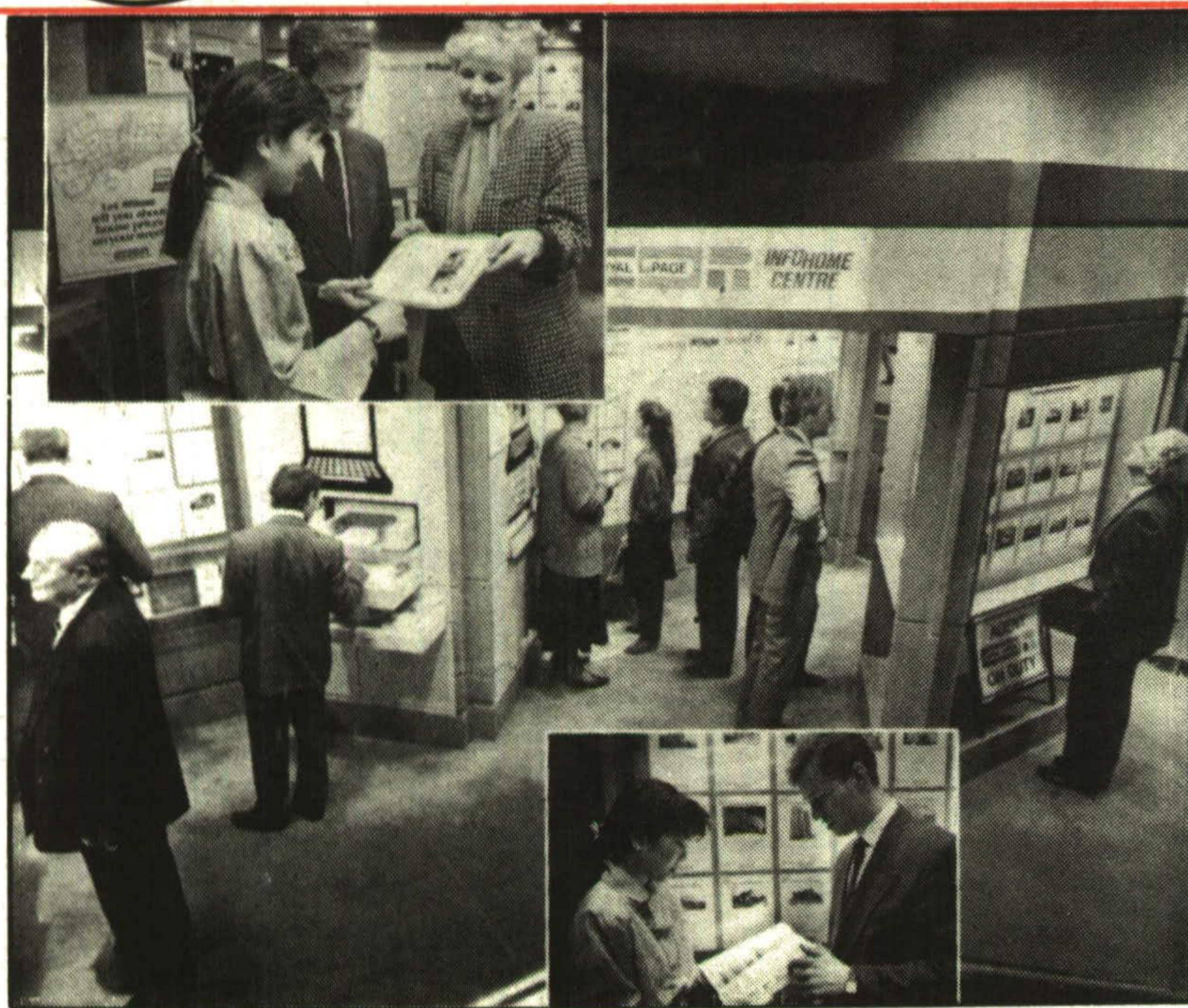
