
Driving for charity at Mohawk

Kara MacDonald, Sarah Vingoe and Gareth Lichty also set club records at the event.


Lichty claimed silver in the 200 metre freestyle event for 11 and 12 year-old boys. He added bronze in the 50 metre butterfly and 200 metre

individual medley, fourth in the 100 metre backstroke, fifth in the 50 metre freestyle event and sixth in the 100 metre freestyle. MacDonald and Vingoe competed in the 13 and 14 year-old girls events. MacDonald claimed gold in the 100 metre backstroke event and


