

SPRING YARD & GARDEN COLLECTION SCHEDULE

The Town of Halton Hills is expanding its yard and garden waste collection schedule in the hopes of diverting even greater volumes of refuse from our landfill. This program will run in conjunction with our Home Composting Program. Home composters will be available again this year pending provincial funding.

Materials such as grass clippings, flower stalks, leaves and other related yard and garden wastes are acceptable for pick up. Brush put at the curb for collection should be bundled or tied in lengths no greater than 4 feet (1-2 m). Twigs or branches should not exceed 1/2 inch (12 mm) in diameter.

Please place your yard and garden materials at the curbside in clear plastic bags before 7:30 am on the following days:


Changes at Georgetown Hospital
