

### SEEDING A LAWN

After the lawn site has been prepared properly and a good seed mixture purchased, it is finally time to seed. Seeding is best done in the spring or fall. The summer time heat makes it difficult for seed to germinate.


Use a drop spreader or rotary spreader, and seed at 2 1/2 kg to 3 kg (4-6 lbs.) per 100 m<sup>2</sup> (1000 ft<sup>2</sup>). Divide the recommended seeding rate in half, and seed in two directions. After seeding, rake over the lawn to just cover the seeds. Seed should never be planted deeper than twice its depth in the soil. Some people prefer to spread top soil over a new lawn. This is not recommended, because you disturb the even plantings, and risk burying the tiny seeds. If you wish to do this, you must be careful not to place more than 1/8" of soil on the seed (just enough to hide the seed).

Next, the lawn should be rolled in multiple directions. This is the only time that a lawn should ever be rolled. A light rolling at this time puts the seed in close contact with the soil which is critical. If it is a small area, simply walking over the area with flat soled shoes will help push the seed into the soil.

Water the lawn thoroughly. Never allow water to puddle or stream, because this will carry the seeds away. Keep the lawn constantly moist. If the seed is allowed to dry out, it may not survive.

After approximately one month, the lawn should be ready for its first mowing.


